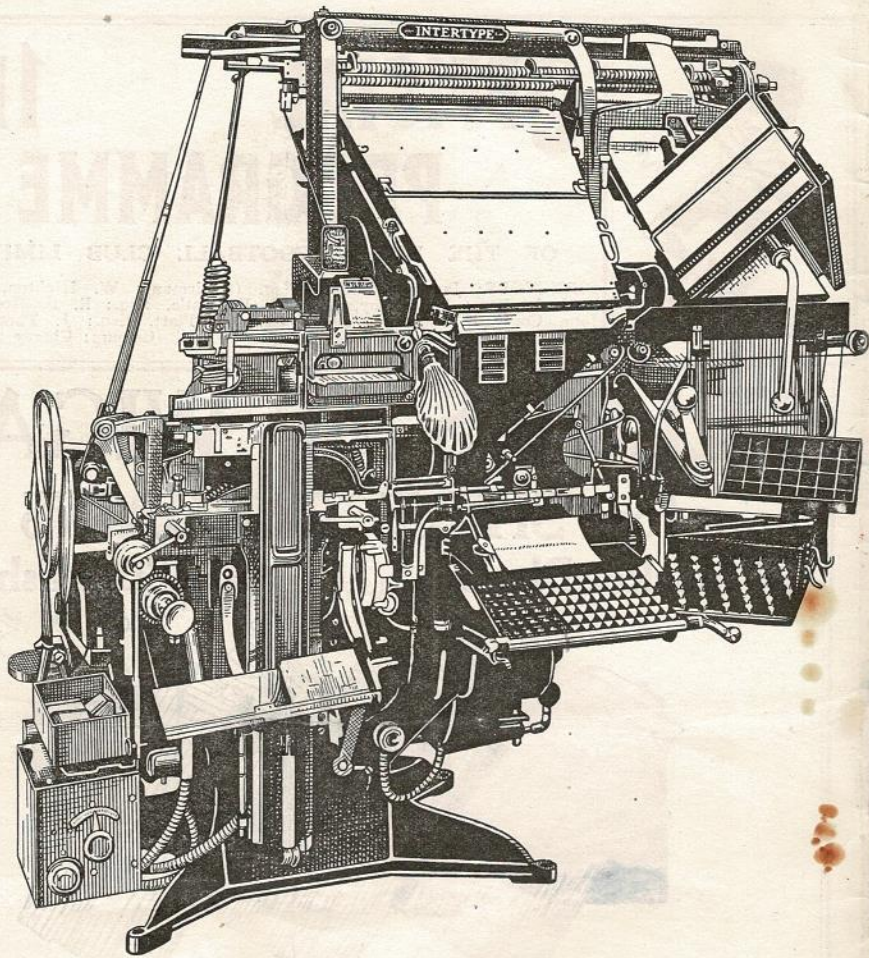

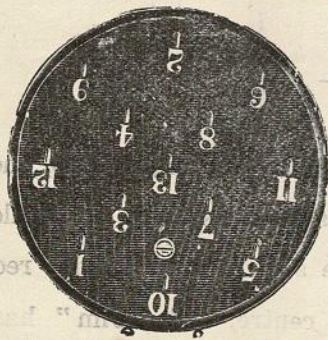

NOTES.

It is 35 years to-day since Central Park was opened with a League match against Batley, and it will be interesting to some of the older school if we repeat the names of the players who took part on that memorable occasion. Jacky Mason "Safety Pin" operated at full back, and the three-quarters were Jimmy Barr (who scored the first try on the ground), Eckersley, Macauley and Benny Rouse. Joe Nelson and Rothwell, the half-backs, and the forwards were Jack Brown, Hilton, Collier, Halliwell, Vickers, Jack Barton, Beesley, and Harry Ball (the latter now being a member of the Board of Directors of the Club).

Mr. George Taylor and Mr. Samuel Latham were joint Secretaries at that time, but Mr. Latham later secured an appointment with Halifax, and Mr. Taylor was later appointed full-time Secretary, a position which he has held for the last 35 years.

From 1902 onwards, Wigan's motto has been "Go one better." Important signings of famous players have been made with frequent regularity, viz., Dai Harris, Johnny Thomas, Percy Coldrick, Charlie Seeling, Massa Johnson, Jerry Shea, Gwyn Thomas, Dicky David, Jack Price, T. Howley, L. B. Todd, the Salford manager, Jimmy Leytham,

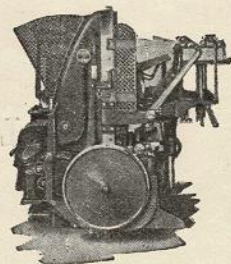
