Crown Flatt Jottings.

The revival at Crown Flatt which I mentioned a short while ago is now taking place and the last three games in which Dewsbury have taken part have shown the capabilities of the side. Although as yet no league points have been collected, they have been unfortunate not to have at least two to their credit, for the match against Leeds at Crown Flatt was only lost by one point. In this match the team gained a moral victory and even the Leeds press writers acknowledge that Dewsbury did not deserve to lose.

There were many incidents in this match that are still talked of in Dewsbury sporting circles.

The Leeds match was partially forgotten with the cup game at Castleford on Saturday. The large contingent of Dewsbury supporters who made the journey to Wheldon Lane were delighted at the form of their team and the ultimate result.

Although there was only a two points margin at the close Dewsbury were undoubtedly the better team and were worthy winners.

As a result of this success they have been rewarded by a home game in the second round against the winners of the Halifax-Wakefield re-play. This should prove a very attractive tie and result in a good "gate."

Our visitors to-day from Oldham lost their cup game on Saturday against Warrington by 4 points to two points.

They have however a good side this season and were responsible a fortnight ago in checking Halifax after the Thrum Hall side had been obtaining big victories.

Many of their players will be new to Crown Flatt and we extend a hearty welcome to both the new and old players. Our friendship with the "Watershedding" folk goes back to 1912 when we beat them in the R.L. Cup Final at Headingley.

On Saturday we have another home game against Newcastle and although the "babes" are not doing anything great so far this season they are capable of providing surprises, as they did last season when they beat Dewsbury at Crown Flatt.

The cup match has not yet been arranged but will of course have to be mid-week.
