agement knows it—the players know it. They are out
to do their stuff to-day—everyone of them; but are
you?

Try for 100 per cent.

Are those of you who have been causing, perhaps unwittingly, the canker to go into things during the week by your criticisms, prepared to do your whack? While we have been attempting to build up confidence in our own selves, all working towards the one end of bringing success to-day, training and planning specially, attempting to encourage as far as possible 100 per cent. assurance before this big day arrives, some have applied the counter.

How encouraging to all those who are going to fight their hardest this afternoon? How indicative of the method of some in team management? This is my uncensored reply to them. Let them think it over. Let them think what their responsibility will be if by mischance the great effort by one and all at Odsal this week does not succeed. In other words—everything possible has been achieved inside the Odsal camp this week, with players and officials spending every spare minute in the one big hope that we shall go a step nearer Wembley, but not by some outside.

No Bradford team has ever had the honour to go there. We are hoping. The players know what is wanted and expected of them. They are determined to give a hundred per cent. They are offering it without it being demanded. They themselves want to make that Wembley grade. They have confidence in themselves that they can go one leg further to-day.
