FACTS

- 1 The field of play shall not exceed 110 yards in length and 75 yards in breadth, and shall be as near those dimensions as practicable.
- 2 On each goal-line and equidistant from the touch-lines shall be two upright posts, called goal-posts, exceeding 11 feet in height, placed 18 feet 6 inches apart and joined by a cross-bar 10 feet from the ground. The cross-bar shall not extend beyond the goal posts.
- 3 The ball may be passed or knocked from one player to another provided it be not passed, knocked or thrown forward
- 4 An off-side player, provided he is not within the five yards limit, or engaged in a "play the ball," is placed onside :
 - (a) When an opponent has run five yards with the ball.
 - (b) When the ball has been kicked or played by an opponent.
 - (c) When one of his side has run in front of him with the ball.
 - (d) When one of his side has run in front of him having kicked the ball when behind him.
