THIS PLAY-THE-BALL BOGEY

HERE IT IS

When a player is tackled, the ball can only be brought into play with the foot, the player dropping it on the ground directly in front of him for that purpose, when it can be kicked by either side in any direction. Neither player playing the ball is allowed to stand with one foot lifted awaiting the dropping of the ball on the ground. Both players must face the respective goal lines. If the player is on the ground he is allowed to regain his feet without delay with the ball in his possession. Only one player from each side will be permitted to play the ball and one player from each side (to act as half back) be allowed to stand not less than one yard behind the players playing the ball. All other players within a radius of 10 yards must stand at least 3 yards behind the player acting as halfback.

On any breach of this law the non-offending side shall be awarded a penalty kick.

It is not imperative for the tackled player to stand erect before dropping the ball.

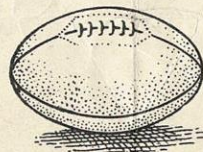
