No team to visit Borough Park has a closer link with Cumberland than our visitors to-day. Many Cumberland players have rendered great service to Oldham. When the Lancashire club won the then Northern Union Cup in 1898-99 season a Cumbrian, Tom Fletcher, was their shining light in the back division. Many will remember Billy Dixon (Maryport), Owens and Mears (Seaton), Spottiswood (Carlisle), Tosh Holliday and Fred Ashworth (Aspatria).

Then we all know what a player Joe Ferguson, the Ellborian, was for Oldham from season 1899-1900 until he retired in season 1923-24. What a record! Then there was our native townsman, Jim Parkinson, not only as a player but in turn as President of the Oldham club, and always an active member of the Committee. He has been a tower of strength for the club in the town of his adoption.

This will be Oldham's fifth visit to Cumberland. First time was in 1899, to Calva Meadow, Seaton, for the benefit of the Village Club, as compensation for the loss of Tom Fletcher, J. Owens and W. Mears. Then in 1900 Oldham came to Lonsdale Park, when the Workington club made a vain attempt to run a professional team. In 1903 Oldham met and defeated Maryport on the Athletic Ground, in a N.U. cup-tie. In April 1921, they played a Cumberland team on Bradbury Avenue, Netherton, in Joe Ferguson's benefit match.
