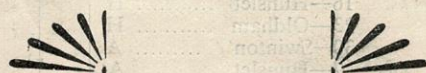

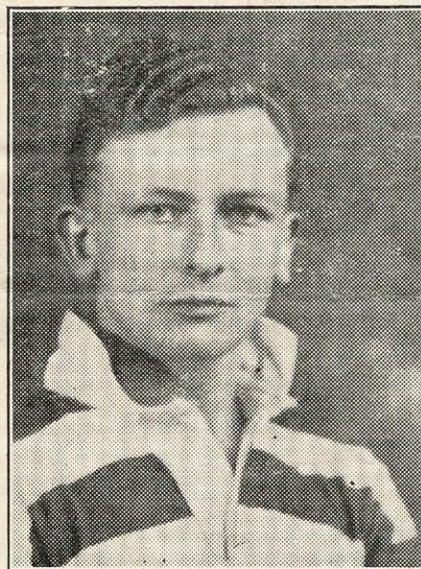

HEDLEY RODGERS

Hedley Rodgers, our brilliant left-wing threequarter from Egremont, is in his 26th year. He played as centre-threequarter for the Hensingham Club when they won the Cumberland Cup three years in succession, at the same time as Jeff Bowden (Huddersfield). At that time he was outstanding, and in every way hall-marked for a future. His chance came when Workington Town decided to run a professional team. In their search for players they heard of this promising player from Egremont. He was immediately signed and every supporter of the club will agree that he was a good capture.

With the exception of the match against Batley, at home, he maintained his place in 41 League and Cup matches. He scored 13 tries. Hedley is equally at home in attack or defence, he is always in position; in fact, had he possessed a little more sprinting power, he would have been one of the best threequarters in the game; played for his County against Yorkshire at Leeds last season, and if given a chance against the same County this season he would not let his County down. Scored his first try this season against Halifax on Saturday.
