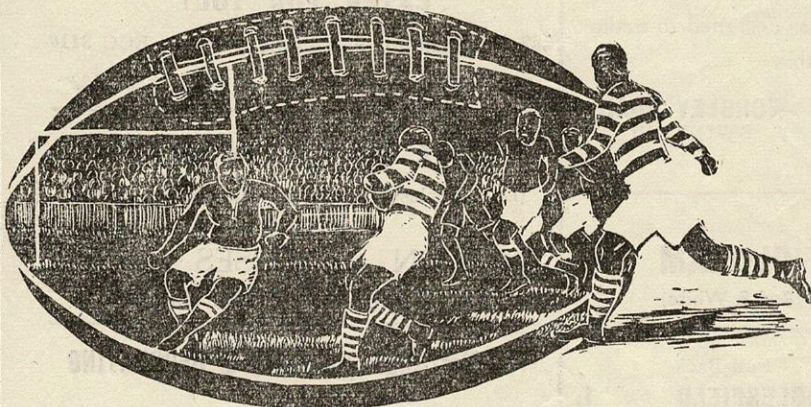

INFORMATION

UNFAIR PLAY: AWARDED OR DISALLOWING A TRY.

The referee shall award a try if, in his opinion, one would undoubtedly have been obtained but for unfair play by the defending side, or encroachment of spectators. Or, he shall disallow a try and adjudge a touchdown if, in his opinion, a try would undoubtedly not have been gained but for unfair play by the attacking side. In case of a try so allowed, the kick at goal shall be taken at any point on a line passing through the spot where the ball was when such unfair play or encroachments took place. A player may, for the purpose of getting a try in a more favourable position, pick up a ball lying motionless over his opponents' goal-line.

TACKLED IN IN-GOAL.

If a player when over the goal-line and in possession of the ball be tackled before the ball is grounded, a scrum, five yards from the goal-line, shall be ordered.
