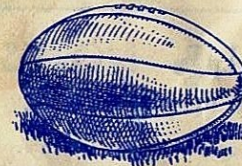

To-day marks the start of a new season which from a playing point of view may well show a marked improvement. The team-building of last year, with the acquisition of Chris Brereton as player-coach, should soon show results, but your directors are not unmindful of the present side's shortcomings. A first-class team cannot be attained without first-class support, and it will be the latter, during the coming season, which will prove the deciding factor in team strengthening.

The fantastic figures demanded to-day for ready-made, experienced players are simply beyond the Club's resources, but it is hoped that an improved team will result in the much needed increase in membership.

An "A" team is to be run again in the Yorkshire Senior Competition—with Norman Foster in charge—and use will be made of it to give trials to promising players.

A number of Keighley's present players have graduated from local junior football, and with the revival of the Keighley and District Junior Rugby League the directors have made Brereton and Foster available to the league for lectures and instruction. Any promising local junior will be given every encouragement and opportunity to make progress.

The Supporters' Club, which since it was re-formed has effected many improvements to the ground, has now embarked upon an ambitious scheme for the provision of new dressing rooms and referees' accommodation, which is at present among the worst in the Rugby League.
