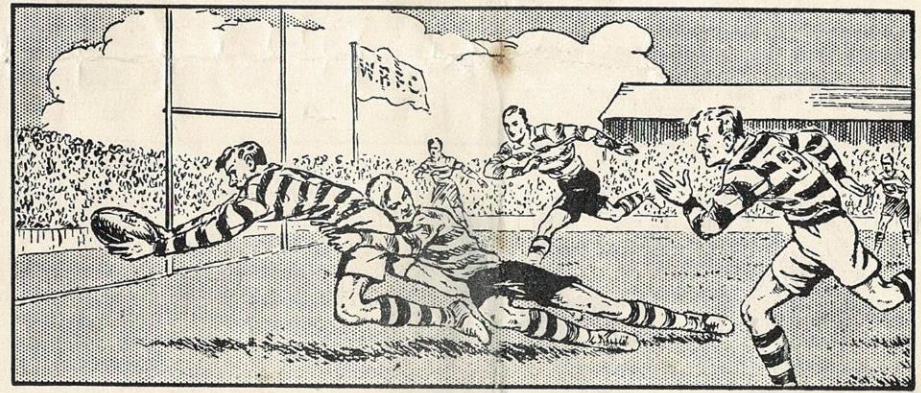

time to heal. J. L. Madden, originally  
chosen to play in the "A" team to-day,  
takes the right wing position in the first  
team at Oldham.

Wigan and District League and the  
London League realised £97/1/-, a very  
satisfactory figure. We have received the
