It is also worthy of note that

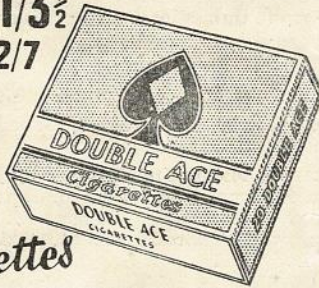
