

## CLUB NOTES

We welcome as our visitors today Oldham, who invariably provide attractive opposition at Belle Vue. This season they have been having a most successful time and have lost only three league matches. They occupy second position in the league table with 47 points, three fewer than Warrington, who have, however, played two games more. Oldham's only defeat at Watersheddings was against Warrington by 12 points to 8. At Salford and Workington they have lost, while at Whitehaven the score was two points each.

Hardman at full-back impressed with his sound tackling, and Hampton did well in the pack. To play against Warrington in their first match from junior football was no easy task, and they can both feel satisfied about their debut.
