### NEW PLAY THE BALL INTERPRETATION

In an endeavour to open up the game from play the ball incidents, new instructions have been issued. They are as follows :

" If either the player playing the ball after a tackle, or the acting half back to whom the ball is heeled, are tackled in possession without the ball having been touched by any other player, then a scrum shall be ordered.

" If the player playing the ball, or the acting half back, run with the ball and score a try, the new interpretation would not affect play, as no tackle has been made.

" Should the acting half back (or the player playing the ball) kick the ball forward, regain possession without any other player touching it, and subsequently be tackled, a scrum shall be formed."

Please give the new instructions two or three weeks' grace, and then, should you have any helpful comments, do not fail to let us have them.
