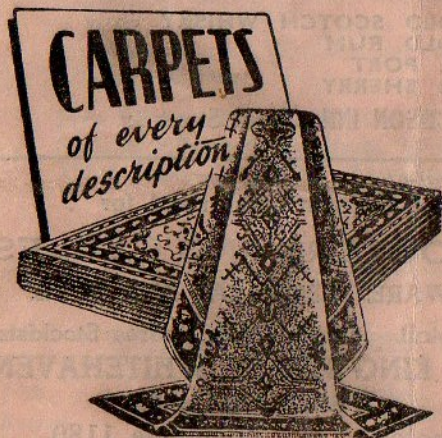

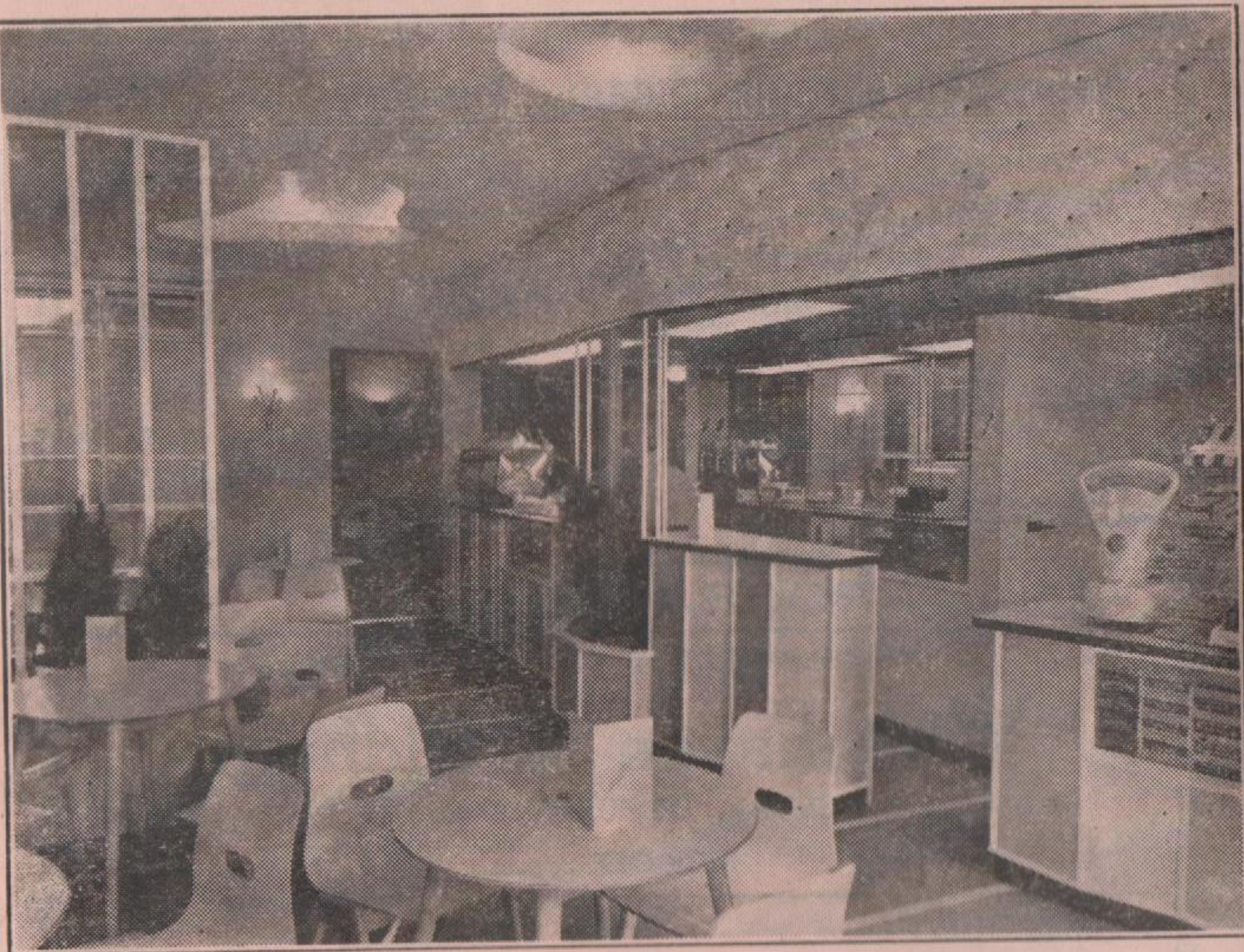

Campbell is to visit a specialist in Edinburgh to have his collar bone reset.

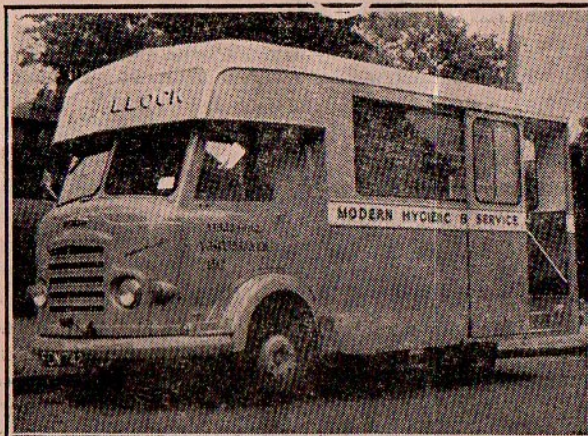
King has visited Leeds and hopes to have an operation on his knee in the near future.

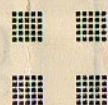
