### CLUB NOTES

The closing stages of our home game against Leigh were decidedly disappointing and came as rather an anti-climax to what had happened before. For quite an hour we more than held our own and looked good enough to win, and so the subsequent collapse was really astonishing—and disappointing. Yet there are signs that it will not be long before we turn the corner. Gordon Brown, we are sure, will be a decided asset when he settles down with his colleagues, and Todd, too, gave quite an encouraging display. Until such time as they do settle down, we are bound to have anxieties. But we shall have to exercise patience—of one thing we are quite sure, that before long we will be on the upward grade. Eyre, we are glad to say, is resuming light training, so it should not belong before we are back at strength.

We have certainly a big test today in the visit of Oldham, who for the past three or four seasons have been right in the front rank as contenders for the League Championship. They are well placed in the league table, and it would be a great performance today if we could halt their progress. In years gone by we have generally given a good account of ourselves against them in what has usually been an attractive game. We remember with affection Alec Givvons, their forward who was such a favourite down here, and there were others who always helped to make Oldham very popular visitors here. So a special welcome to them today.

Our team building experience in the "A" team is also a slow business and a week ago they disappointed at Dewsbury being beaten by 14 pts. All we can do is keep persisting in our endeavours to build up the side to its former status. The recent performance against Wigan "A" showed that there is football in the side and getting displays like that regularly must be one of our immediate aims.

Difficulties have arisen which do not make it practicable for us to retain Trumble, so today Chapman will be given his chance with the senior side.
