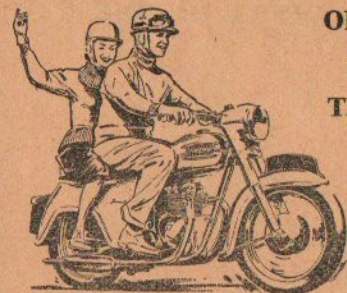

After a good fight in the first half at Wakefield, we had to submit to their stronger forces after the interval, and Trinity went into the final for the Yorkshire Cup. They will meet Leeds in the final at Odsal on 11th November.

Jeff Stevenson made an unfortunate reappearance against Bradford Northern. He received another injury which prevented him playing against Wakefield and Blackpool, but his hopes of being fit for today's match to play against his County colleague, Kellett, were in doubt.

Their association in the match in which Yorkshire defeated the Australians is still talked about by those who had the pleasure of witnessing that memorable encounter.

Jeff had also to miss leading Yorkshire against Lancashire this week and had to decline an invitation to play in the representative match in Paris on Thursday. His successor at Headingley was called on to fill the scrum-half vacancy.

Our "A" team, with seven successive wins heads the Senior Competition, and will be the first to hold the banner presented by the Yorkshire Federation of Supporters' Clubs. They have been drawn at home to Featherstone Rovers "A" in the first round of the Senior Competition Cup.

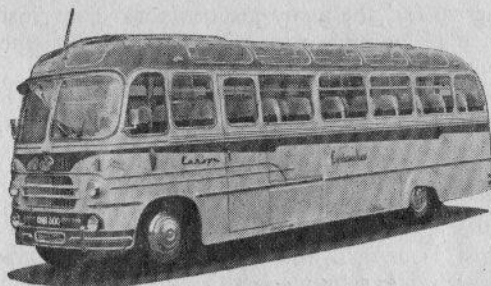
