HULL v. OLDHAM

DIVISION ONE

Monday, 27th May, 1963.

Kick-off 7-0 p.m.

The Visitors

For our last match of this very extended season, we welcome our friends from Oldham. At the time of writing these notes our visitors occupy the last position in the first division with 15 pts. from 27 matches played. After a long succession of defeats, victory over Hull K.R. last Tuesday came too late to have any bearing on Oldham's relegation problems. Oldham, like ourselves, have incurred serious injury problems this season and such factors have obviously been a contributory cause of their lack of success.

Oldham were, with us, one of the founder members of the Northern Union and it was their representative Joseph Platt who was the first honorary secretary and guiding arm of the new league. In 1899 they became the first Lancashire side to win the Northern Union Challenge Cup and were subsequently finalists in five finals, four of these in successive seasons. They have also appeared in nine Championship finals, winning four, fourteen Lancashire Challenge Cup finals, winning 9, and have been Lancashire County Champions five times and runners-up six times.

During recent years there have been many exciting cup matches between our two clubs. In 1957 we met in the Championship final at Odsal Stadium which resulted in a 15 pts. to 14 win for Oldham. The next season we finished 4th in the League and visited Watersheddings for the play-off. In a tip-top match we won by 20 pts to 8 and went on to win the Championship, beating Workington 20 pts to 3 at Odsal. In 1960 we met in an exciting Challenge Cup semi-final at Swinton which we won 12 pts to 9 and so made our second successive visit to Wembley. The next season we again met Oldham in the Challenge Cup but this time it was in the first round when we won 4 pts to 2 at the Boulevard. Our first round opponents in 1962 were again Oldham and this time they won by 32 pts to 16 at Watersheddings.

Our league fixture at Oldham this season was played on Easter Monday and we had a good win of 18 pts to 3. The visitors will no doubt be very anxious to reverse that result today and as both teams are capable of playing good open rugby we hope that this meeting will prove as entertaining as previous encounters.

Match Review

Our last three outings, Hull K.R. at home, Huddersfield and Featherstone away all provided disappointing displays and defeat in each case. Following so closely on the vastly improved performances against St. Helens and Leeds (Home and Away) one again wonders at the continuing change of fortunes which this first season of the two divisions has provided.


