COMPETITION RULES

Each side consists of seven players, the usual formation being three forwards and four backs. Selection may be made from eight players, but once a game has started substitutes are not allowed.

Each game is played seven minutes each way (except the final which is played 10 minutes each way). If at the end of the usual period the tie is drawn, ends are changed every seven (or 10) minutes, the first side to score being the winners.
