## CONSTITUTIONAL CHANGES

This might be a good thing in itself, provided that there is no back-log of fixtures due to the weather.

Saturday, 24th April is scheduled for a play-off of the top sixteen clubs in the League. This is a Competition in itself, and is a play-off for the Championship Trophy.

The top sixteen teams in the final table will be paired as follows:-1 v 16; 8 v 9; 4 v 13; 5 v 12; 2 v 15; 7 v 10; 3 v 14; 6 v 11. The numbers indicate league position, and the higher placed team in all rounds shall have ground advantage-except for the final.
