CLUB NOTES

This evening's game against our old friends and rivals from Oldham is the third at the Athletic Grounds within the past six days.

Unfortunately, the two previous encounters with Warrington and Wigan did not produce any of the points we desperately need to get away from the foot of the table. Against Warrington, it can be fairly said that Hornets were unlucky to lose. Many rate our form against the league leaders as the best of the season.

Therefore, it was something of anti-climax and a disappointment that we should receive such a hammering at the hands of Wigan on Tuesday night. The Hornets played pluckily enough but on the night they were plainly outclassed by a Wigan side which had a true Wembley look about it.

Hornets are not likely to find Oldham such a power-packed, speedy handful to-night. Nonetheless, it will require a tremendous team effort if two points are to be won.

After an indifferent spell following their Cup exit at Hunslet, Oldham appeared to regain their form in their highly merited win over Workington at Watersheddings on Monday night.

Over the years Oldham have been able to find forward stars. Their latest discovery is 17 year old farmer's boy, Bob Irving. Bob, spotted by coach Frank Dyson at Huddersfield, has been putting on some headline-catching displays in the last few weeks. His laconic comment to the cauliflower ears he has recently developed was "Well, I'm a rugby player now." We will be able to judge that to-night, "cauliflowers" or not.

The other three new signings Oldham have made this season are all from Wigan. South African fullback John Winton followed out-half Stan McLeod and centre Jim McCormack to Watersheddings only a few weeks ago. Already he has paid off a slice of the £2,500 fee involved by kicking quite a number of goals, including two vital ones which helped Oldham to beat Workington.

McLeod, of course, was in the Wigan team beaten at Wembley by Wakefield a couple of years ago, and McCormack made his debut for Oldham against the Hornets in the Charity Cup game at the beginning of the season and shortly afterwards won his Lancashire County cap.
