

WATERSHEDDINGS NEWS AND VIEWS

One wonders, as I write these notes, will it again be a waste of time and effort? We are getting used to having matches postponed. A fortnight ago almost the full Rugby League programme was postponed because of the frosty grounds and last Saturday one match was cancelled because of the waterlogged pitch.

However, the prospects of tonight's match going on are much better, and I am sure the players as well as supporters will welcome the return to action.

Our last match was way back on January 8th, when we conquered the mighty St. Helens at Watersheddings. This was a magnificent performance by Oldham and they became the first side to take both League points from the "Saints" this season. From the word 'go' the boys got on top, and apart from about ten minutes at the start of the second half, they stayed there, and in the end they won the game far more convincingly than the score of 13-9 would suggest. This victory brought our unbeaten run to four and, of course, we will be all out to make it five this evening in this re-arranged match.

OUR OPPONENTS

Tonight we welcome to Watersheddings our friends from across the Pennines. Hunslet, it will be remembered, lost narrowly in the final of the Challenge Cup against Wigan at Wembley last May after perhaps the greatest Cup Final ever played on the 'lush' Wembley turf. If they play in the same manner this evening and we reproduce our form against St. Helens, then this game should be a treat to watch.

Hunslet have some fine players in their ranks at present, three of whom have been honoured this season with their selection for Great Britain. In fact, it was because these players had been chosen to play for the country that this match was postponed earlier in the season. The three of them, Geoff. Shelton, Ken Eyre and Bill Ramsey, are all in the running for the forthcoming Australasian Tour—we wish them luck.

The two clubs last met on New Year's Day at Parkside, in the League, when Oldham won after a hard game by 7 points to 3. The boys from Yorkshire will, of course, be out to avenge that defeat.


