### CLUB NOTES

Barring a miracle, this evening's game will be the last senior match of the season at the Athletic Grounds. Two very disappointing performances at Batley last Saturday and at Liverpool on Easter Monday have virtually ruled the Hornets out of the Top Sixteen play-off.

The only consolation the two games brought was that Graham Starkey equalled the club points scoring record of 221 established by the late Walter Gowers in the 1933-34 season. Now Starkey has two games, including tonight's clash with Oldham, in which to kick six more goals for his "ton". Incidentally, he is also the club's leading try-scorer with 11 tries, one more than ex-Oldhamer Jimmy Gaskell.

With Oldham assured of a Top Sixteen place and Hornets out of the running to all intents and purposes, one hopes that this "Derby" will contain less "needle" than previous encounters. Certainly spectators do not want to see a repetition of the grim exhibition last Christmas mercifully brought to a premature end by the fog with neither side having scored and one player from each side sent off.

Like Hornets, Oldham have had to struggle along for most of the season without key players. Their £5,000 full-back signing from Huddersfield, Brian Curry, has been in and out of the side with leg trouble. Loose-forward Dave Parker, possibly one of the classiest loose-forwards playing, is still fighting to regain his form after a serious knee injury and quicksilver out-half Tom Warburton broke a leg the week after playing against the Hornets. Fortunately, Warburton has made a quick ecovery and is back in the team.

Obviously, however, Oldham's reserve strength, in the pack at least, has proved more than adequate and in the ubiquitous Peter Smethurst and young Warburton they have two consistent matchwinners whom Hornets will have to watch very carefully tonight.

Just before the Cup-ties, Oldham splashed £6,000 to sign Shelton, the Gt. Britain Test centre from Hunslet, and since the departure of Frank Dyson from Watersheddings he has temporarily taken over as coach. At the time of writing, however, he was a doubtful starter for tonight's game because of a damaged thigh.

The plans will now go for approval, and we hope to commence building as soon as the season ends, so that the complete facilities will be available for the commencement of next season.



#### RECORDS

The Hornet's try-scoring record is held by Jack Williams with 30 in the 1934-35 season.

Walter Gowers kicked 109 goals in the 1933-34 season and also scored one try — 221 points.

Graham Starkey has this season equalled 221 points with 94 goals and 11 tries. We wish him well tonight and we hope in beating the record he also manages to kick 100 goals. Well done, Graham.

Herbert Lees, who played at full-back for the Hornets, kicked ten goals against Glasshoughton on February 19th, 1938.

The Hornets ended the 1914-15 season as a "first-four club", being beaten at Huddersfield in the championship play-off semi-final by 27 points to 2.

From October 10th, 1914, to March 6th, 1915, the Hornets played 25 matches without defeat, the sequence being ended at Wigan on the latter date. The Hornets won 21 and drew four of their last 25 fixtures, which included seven cup-ties, one of these being the final of the Lancashire Cup, in which they defeated Wigan at Salford by three points to two.
