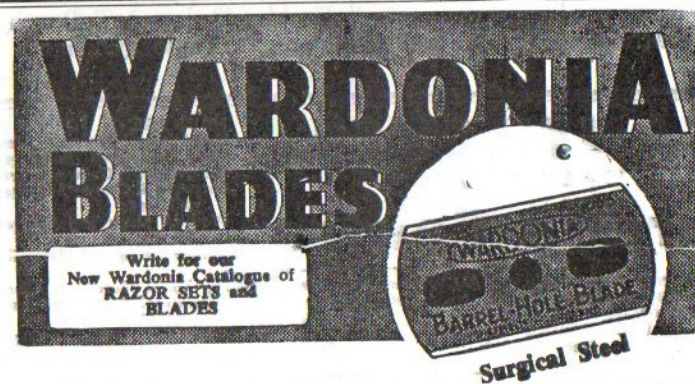
## THE MEN FROM WATERSHEDDINGS

Tickets will be on sale next week for the visit to Wilderspool of the Australians on September 30th. The tickets will be priced at 7/6 for the stands. Ground charge is the same—4/-. This game is bound to be a big attraction. A lot of followers will want to get a first look at the Tourists. Early application for stand tickets should be made.

**UNGENTLEMANLY CONDUCT**

A clause is included in the Laws which gives the referee power to penalise any offence which is not in the true spirit of the game. This is necessary because it is impossible to make a detailed list of all the circumstances which could arise in a game and which would merit a penalty award. This is in effect a re-wording of the 'ungentlemanly conduct' clause.

The laws of the game have been re-written by Mr. W. Fallowfield, the R.L. secretary. Copies of the booklet can be obtained by sending 1/6 post free from R.L. Headquarters, 180 Chapeltown Road, Leeds.

**ROAD SAFETY ★****STOP - LOOK - LIVE****★ SAFETY FIRST****OFFICIAL NOTICES**

The Rugby League World Championship games will be played at Brisbane, Sydney and Auckland on May 25th, 1968. The play-off is at Sydney on June 10th.

Members of clubs and their supporters who are interested in making the trip by air should communicate with Mr. W. Fallowfield, the Secretary, at 180 Chapeltown Road, Leeds 7, as soon as possible.

By travelling in groups it is possible to gain a personal reduction of 30 per cent. in the rate of travel. This amounts to approximately £140—which is well worth travelling in groups.

All tickets for the R.L. Challenge Cup final—that is to say, stand tickets—have been disposed of some time ago. The final is not until May 11th of next year, but there has been a greater demand than ever at this time of the season for ground tickets at five shillings.

It should be noted that these tickets enable the holder to be under cover. Early application is advisable, but applications should include a cheque, money order or postal order to cover the cost, as well as stamped addressed envelope. Tickets can be obtained from the R.L. Office in Leeds.

The Test matches against the Australians will be played on the following dates: At Headingley, Leeds, on October 21st; at White City Stadium, London, on November 3rd, and at Swinton on December 9th.

Stand tickets for the three games can be obtained from the clubs or from R.L. headquarters in Leeds. The price of the tickets is £1, 15/- and 12/6.

R.L. officials, players (professional and amateur), as well as referees, linesmen, anyone officially connected with the game, and R.L. journalists, are invited to take part in a golf competition for the Sharman Trophy at Ilkley on October 17th. Entry forms can be obtained from R.L. headquarters.

**UP TO LONDON**

Two Warrington amateur clubs are to help the game's pioneers in London to publicise Rugby League in the South by playing matches against two of the teams in the new London R.L. Association during the weekend of September 16th-17th, says the "Liverpool Echo".

Crosfields, one of the strongest clubs in South West Lancashire, will play against Hackney, one of the strongest London teams, and Faircloughs, comparatively new members of the Warrington League, will oppose a team from Ealing.

Ray Dennett, secretary of the Warrington R.L. Referees' Society, will travel down to referee one of the matches. About 25 players from each club will make the trip.

The R.L. Disciplinary Committee has suspended the following players: Owen (Rochdale), five matches; Kelley (Halifax), three matches; Foster (Hull K.R.), four matches; Hepworth (Castleford), two matches; Parker (Liverpool City), one match; Francis (Wigan), one match; Gilfedder (Wigan), one match; Gardiner (Wigan), four matches; Bryant (Castleford), three matches.
