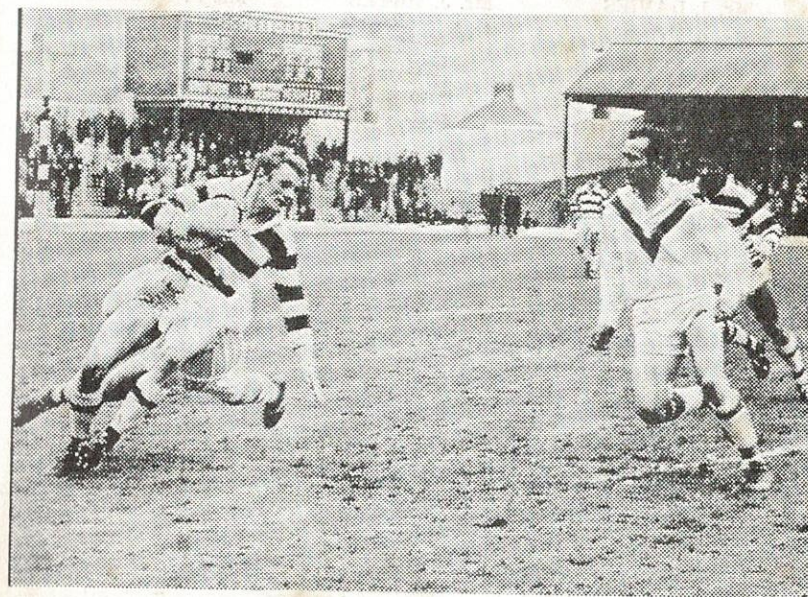

MORE POPULAR VISITORS

Oldham, tonight's visitors, have not reached that fine standard of certain pre-war as well as post-war seasons when their name appeared regularly in the record books. In between the wars there are some of us who remember such great names as Ernie Knapman, a great full-back, as was ex-Guardsman Tommy Rees. The veteran Naughton Park supporters will, of course, go further back than that to recall the exploits of Ferguson, Rix, Sloman, etc., but most of us remember that fine outfit to which Ganley, Little, Winslade, Keith, Davies and Goldswain contributed.

The present side is not as successful as those famous Watersheddings teams in past years, but it can produce some good rugby. We may not see their pack leader Geoff Fletcher, formerly of Leigh, in action. It will be remembered that he smashed his hand when playing against St. Helens in the Lancashire R.L. Challenge Cup final at Central Park, Wigan.

Mal Aspey finds the going tough in our cover picture as former Widnes skipper Frank Myler (St. Helens) and Chemics winger Dennis Brown wait to see what happens.

They have some very good players, and we are familiar with the talents of Derek Whitehead, a fine goal-kicking threequarter, Wilf Briggs, brother of the Warrington forward, who is also a former Leigh stand-off-half, Mick Murphy who seems as if he can figure in any of the positions in the back division.

In the pack are such useful forwards as Stuart Whitehead, Charlie Bott, 'Hooker' Taylor and of course Arthur Hughes, who was a member of our cup-winning Wembley team. Arthur, who is resident at Penketh, finds it difficult to travel to Watersheddings for training and he has been seeking a transfer. His name has been linked with Warrington, and the Wires directors would like to do a deal with Ray Clark, their young loose-forward. At the time of writing the deal has not gone through.

We learn with regret that John Stringer, the Oldham secretary, who was formerly the assistant secretary at Leigh, has been hurt in a motor car accident. We wish him a speedy and complete recovery.

It will have been noted that we have been trying to rearrange our postponed league game with Swinton. This match will now go on at Station Road, Swinton, on Tuesday, January 7th. The kick-off is at 7-30 p.m. As we have won our last four games, two more points tonight would be something in the form of a Christmas present for our loyal supporters. Our team will be doing its best to oblige.

Denis O'Neill, our Lancashire stand-off half-back, is still suffering from pulled thigh muscles and may not be ready just yet. In the meantime Ken Rowse has shown himself to be a capable deputy.

Though George Kemel, our international hooker, and Robin Whitfield, our full-back, are on the transfer list they are still assisting the club, which is a very good sign of the spirit among the players.

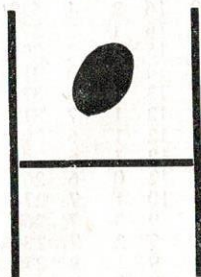

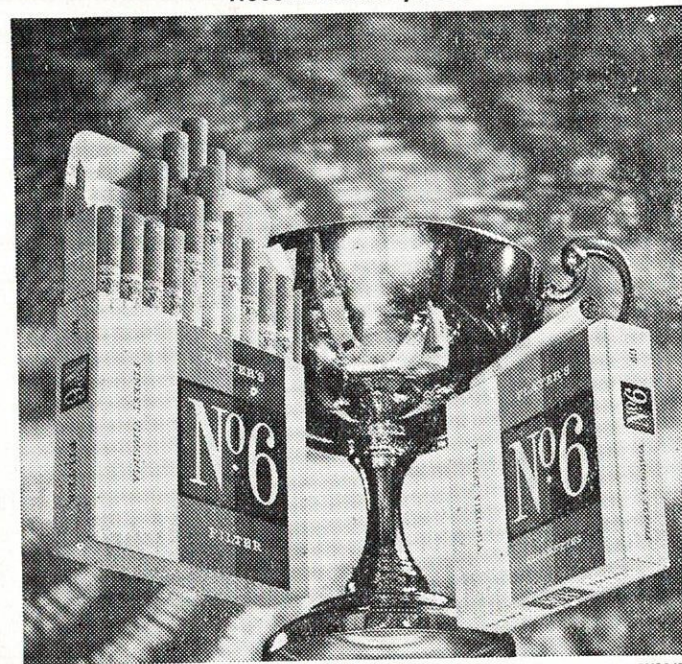
