Oldham have turned their backs now on the 1967-68 season — and there will be no sly glances over the shoulder. Let's face it, no one wants to look back the season past. The Challenge Cup run apart, it was one of those seasons which officials and supporters dread — a transitional period with players coming and going, made all the more uncertain because of an unusually-large crop of injuries

The disappointments were eased somewhat for members by the £8,000 profit, although the cream is taken from the cake when a fair portion of that profit comes from a reduced wage bill.

However, thoughts are now on the new season. What has it got in store for us? Will there be an improvement on last term?

These have been the talking points during the summer lay-off and, generally, the fans seem confident of better fortunes.

Certainly, the season cannot be worse than last. In fact, given a reasonable amount of luck, I feel Oldham could be back to the level they occupied in the three previous seasons — around tenth position in the table.

For this to materialise, however, there will have to be a tremendous improvement in the team's defensive play.

Supporters want more tries. Who can blame them? The best form of defence is attack. But we must not lose sight of the fact that, while the try scoring record last season was comparable with others in recent seasons, the defence record was appalling.

Oldham conceded 127 tries — a fantastic defensive slide when compared with 1966-7 (79), 65-6 (87) and 64-5 (66).

Of course, things invariably run badly for a team that is down and had the side enjoyed more success it is doubtful that so many tries would have been conceded.

How many times did a team with poor morale in the early part of the season open up the flood gates once the opposition got a few points in front?

I suppose this is inevitable and no doubt there will be a big improvement defensively if the side can get that all-important psychological "lift" from a degree of success in the early part of the season.






