REVIEW By ROGER HALSTEAD

(Oldham Evening Chronicle)

Possibly more than ever before, there is talk around the town about the possibilities of turning Oldham Football Club into a limited liability company. Of course, there is a terrific amount involved in any such move and if any subject called for reasoned thinking of all the circumstances, both for and against, this is it.

But I am convinced that the time is approaching when the possibilities must be delved into.

Never before have Rugby League clubs faced such a challenge against apathy and decreasing popularity as they do now.

The crippling thing, of course, is that because of the general decline in the game over the last decade, most clubs are having to meet that challenge at a time when they are at a low ebb, partcularly financially.

At Oldham, a club which now has only around 700 or 800 members, there must be serious doubts about whether the club in its present form is able and ready to meet the fight.

Personally, I doubt it — and I don't mean to be critical of the men in charge at Watersheddings; more the antiquated system on which the club is constitutionally based.

These must be days of drive, vigour and enterprise if Rugby League — to say nothing of Oldham — is to survive.

At league level there are so many factors which cause consternation, that a club cannot afford to be anything but courageous and determined in its deliberations.

And I say the Oldham club is more likely to get that solid foundation as a limited company than it ever will as a members' club.

Members did a wise thing at the last annual meeting when they cut the committee in size from 12 to 9, to be operative from 1970.

I have argued for a long time that a 12-man committee is too unweildy and too large to be an effective working body.

The reduction of three is a forward step and it will be interesting to see what effect the smaller committee has on the general running of the club.

The annual meeting was such a flop in many ways, however, that it hardly gave confidence for the future.

Perhaps the time has come at last for a really big constitutional change in the administration of professional Rugby League in the town.

At least, it's food for thought.


