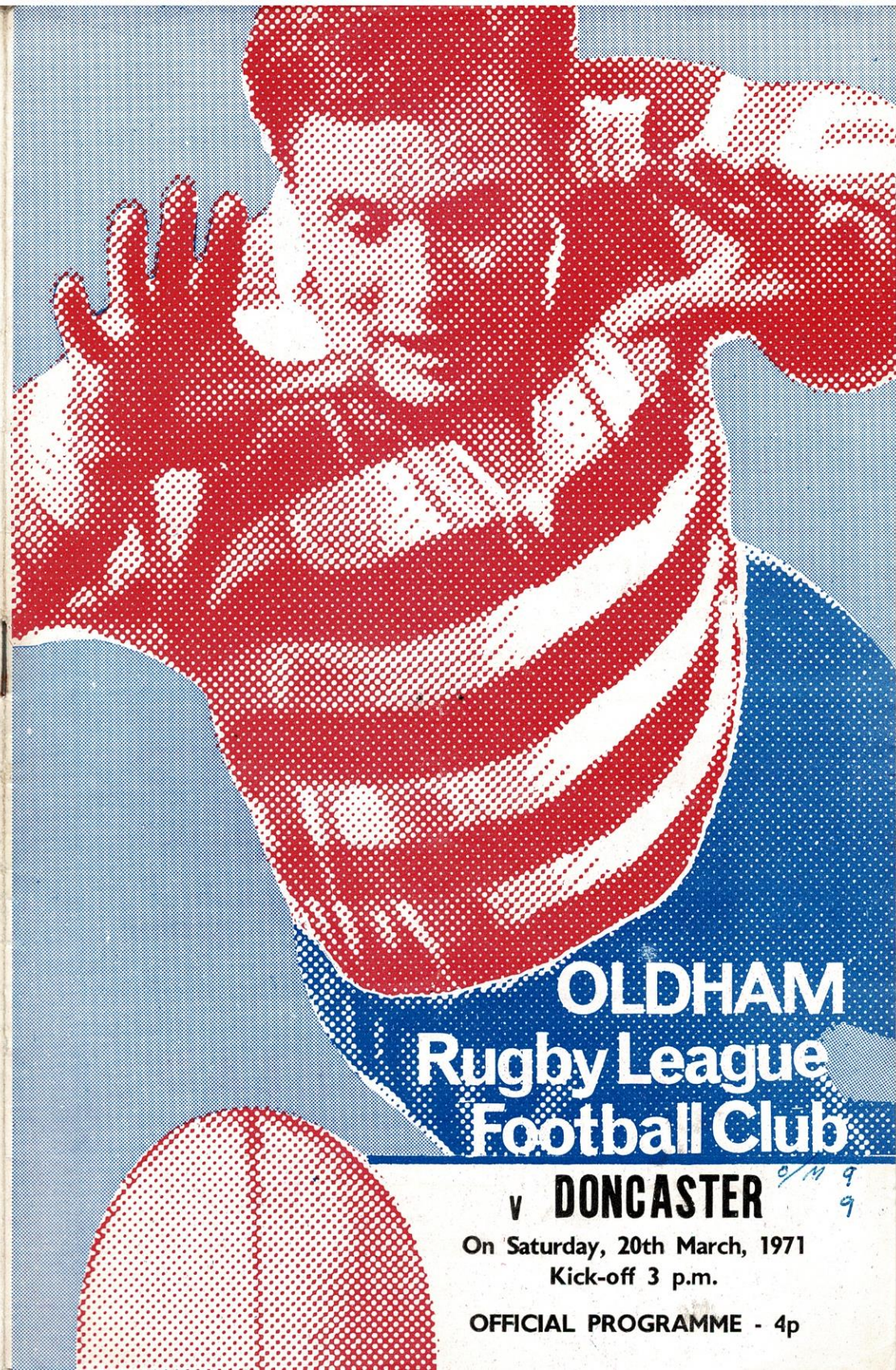

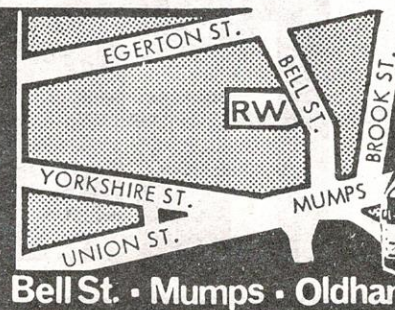

TODAY'S VISITORS

For the second time in the space of four days Oldham are given the opportunity to complete the double over their opponents. Today's visitors, Doncaster, were formed in 1951 and although they were placed 11th at the end of their first season in 1951-52 they have not been in the top twenty since! Success hasn't visited Doncaster very often although they have provided a fair number of surprises in the past. In their early days they pulled off a great win at Leeds, when winger Brian Tasker notched four tries, and in April 1965 they recorded a handsome 43-5 win over Batley. Last season the 'Dons' had a memorable run in the Challenge Cup reaching the quarter-finals when the powerful St. Helens were held to a 4-4 draw. In the replay however, Saints scored a comfortable 36-0 win, but they certainly had an uncomfortable time at Tatters Field.

Whilst Doncaster's forwards are quite a competent force, it is in the backs where the star attractions are to be found. At half-back Gary Brook and Mick McCone form a tricky duo whilst in the threequarter line, David Towle, Ian Fortis and Peter Grainger have been amongst the points in recent weeks. Full-back Graham Wainwright is only 19 and has been playing exceptionally well since his signing from Bentley, the Doncaster junior club. He has also represented the Doncaster amateur league in both open age and under 19 levels. Coaching this enthusiastic South Yorkshire outfit is Cyril Sykes the talented second row forward who was a member of the mighty Hull pack during the middle fifties.

So far Doncaster have won 7 and drawn 2 of their 30 games and so lie in 26th position. The Dons' best win of the season was at Keighley, where they won 16-13 although they pulled off other notable successes against Widnes 12-11, York 14-0 and completed the double over Huyton winning 14-0 at home and 8-5 at Alt Park.

Last September Oldham came away from Tanners Field with a 14-10 victory as part of a 10 match run which yielded 17 points. A home victory is firmly anticipated today and with three close games to come next month the battle for a place in the top fifteen is building up to an exciting climax.

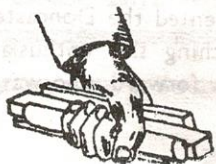

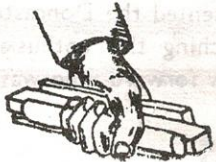

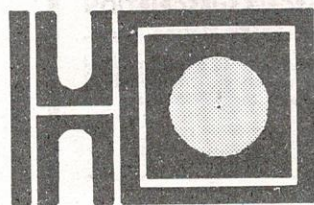

STAN GITTINS LEADS IN MATCH AWARDS POINTS TABLE

For the first time since the opening weeks of the season, Leigh's evergreen captain and coach, Alex Murphy, has lost his leadership of the Player's No. 6 Player of the Match Awards Points Table. The man to do it also hails from Leigh but plays for the Yorkshire Club, Batley. He is Stan Gittins, their full back, whose form in recent weeks has seen him shoot up the table and now he is two points ahead of Murphy. It is not only Gittins who is providing a strong challenge to Murphy.
