

WELCOME TO OLDHAM

After a break of one season it is pleasing to welcome Oldham to Naughton Park once again.

Oldham Football Club, now Oldham Rugby League Club, was formed in 1876 following a challenge match between the local Parish Church Institute and the Oldham Lyceum. A meeting at the Prince Albert Hotel followed, and the club started on its playing career. After one good season it quickly built up a good fixture list, and in October 1877 became the first good-class club in Lancashire to meet a Yorkshire side (Dewsbury Athletic).

Quickly moving into the top strata of Lancashire Rugby Union, county players were selected from the club, and a place was gained on the executive of the Lancashire County Club.

When professionalism began to grow, Oldham were in the van to form the Northern Union, and Joe Platt, the Oldham treasurer, was the first secretary. He held the position for a quarter of a century and was responsible for the negotiations which started our game in New Zealand.

The club has had many great players, from Bill McCutcheon, Gwynne, R. L. Thomas (grandfather of the Grade One referee of the same name), Moffatt, Varley, Arthur Lees, Sammy Lees, Knapman, Brough, Rix, Sloman, Ashworth, Tommy Rees, Lew Rees, and dozens of others. The great team
