So near yet so far. Last Sunday's defeat by Swinton was a bitter pill to swallow, after leading for most of the game, Swinton came back from 4-13 down to win the game by 14 pts. to 13. This defeat, on top of the Featherstone match the week before, really upset our plans for a top four position in the League. However, matters were put right a little on Friday evening when we beat Barrow at Craven Park 16-15, after being 15-6 behind. All the team played well, but the victory was not without cost, for both Peter Gartland and Eddie Brown were injured in the match, but both players will probably be fit for this evening's game.

Tonight it is our pleasure to welcome the Players, Officials and Supporters of the Oldham Club, and a special word of welcome to our former Chairman and former Coach, Arthur Walker and Graham Starkey respectively.

This evening's match is another of double importance to both Clubs, for Oldham are striving hard for a place in the Top 16. They are, at the time of writing, in the 17th position, having collected 27 pts. from the 29 matches played, which is rather remarkable, for around the Christmas period they were third from the bottom of the League.

Neither side have selected their respective teams for this evening's game at the time of writing, although Frank Myler can have few problems about our side. Apart from Eddie Brown and Peter Gartland, the remainder are all fit and raring to go. Alan Hodgkinson gave his shoulder a good testing in the "A" team and had such a good game that he may well find himself in the fifteen for tonight's match.

Oldham, who also had a good win at Doncaster on Saturday, expect little change in their line-up. Negotiations with Doncaster for their scrum-half, Mick McCone, who has been playing trials with the Club, fell through over the week-end, and Tommy Davies may well take over again. The player who is reported to be making a lot of difference to the Oldham side is their new acquisition from Barrow, prop-forward Frank Foster who, since signing before the Cup deadline, has only been on the losing side twice, against Warrington and St. Helens.

During their recent revival, Oldham, over the last four matches, have amassed a staggering 136 points, scoring 32 tries in the process, of which new signing, winger Norman Hodgkinson, has scored eight. The only other new player to the Oldham ranks is their centre-threequarters, Mike Siddall, who joined them from the Halifax Junior League during this term.

**NEXT SEASON'S CHANGES**

Second thinking has taken place since the "Caine" report was first issued and now it would appear that a number of suggestions in the report which it was thought would be adopted, will not now be so. However, some changes have been agreed, including a return to a previous fixture formula, which gives us fixtures with all Lancashire teams, and Dewsbury will be classed as a Lancashire team, as also will Whitehaven and Workington. In addition we will play three Yorkshire teams to make up a league programme of thirty-four matches. This formula means that all derby matches, which are good gate-pullers, will be

played, and for ourselves it means we will be once again playing St. Helens, Wigan, Salford and Leigh, teams which we did not play in the league this season.

The four tackle rule is to be scrapped and the six tackle rule, which has been such a success in "A" team football is to be adopted. Through John Caine the Rugby League are to issue a magazine run something on the lines of one already issued by the Football League. A feature of the magazine is to be a coloured team photograph across the centre pages and the Barrow team are to be featured in the first issue which is expected to be printed in time for distribution around Easter.
