

We extend a warm welcome to the Oldham team and officials. Oldham are battling for a place in the top sixteen and a win for them tonight is most important. They beat us on their own ground in February by 15—12pts. so the stage is set for what we hope will be a most interesting game.

Next Sunday will see the conclusion of another playing season as far as the Bramley club is concerned. Our performance over the season has followed a similar pattern to that of 1970/71 both as regard to the number of games won and total points scored and conceded.

We have had our moments of glory and more moments of disappointments. During the season we have called on 32 players compared with 38 the previous season. Our coach, Keith Holliday, is most emphatic that we have the best playing potential since he joined the Club in 1966. We agree with him. We are sure that had we not suffered a most unusual crop of injuries since January we should have obtained a place in the top sixteen of the League table.

We were very sorry to hear that our prop-forward, David Horne, has broken a leg in an accident at work. Unfortunately this would now appear to put paid to any hope we had of seeing him once again in a black and amber jersey. Dave has a proud record with the Club having made 323 appearances and scored 24 tries. We wish him a speedy recovery.

Our popular captain. John Wolford, saw a specialist the other week and apparently he is suffering from a form of delayed concussion. He was advised to give football a rest for a month but we expect him to be fighting fit at the start of next season.


