## CLUB NOTES

# Barrow v OLDHAM

SUNDAY NOVEMBER 14th 1976

Kick Off 2.30p.m.

After six weeks at Craven Park without first team Rugby it is nice to welcome you all back once again, I hope the weather is good and we are rewarded with a good open game of Rugby League Football. Much has happened since we last appeared at Craven Park we have been to Oldham and were beaten 33 points to nil (we hope to reverse that score to-day), we went to Blackpool in the first round of the John Player Cup and were beaten by one point 16 - 15 by a penalty goal awarded for offside under our own posts in injury time; bad luck indeed.

The best trip of all was to Warrington two weeks ago; with the thoughts in our minds that Warrington had already been to Barrow twice this season and had won on both occasions 40 points to 7 and 38 points to 13 it was only the most optimistic of us that thought we had a good chance of winning: We had just signed Tony Dean and he together with our signing of the previous week Mel Mason made all the difference the ball was being moved around quicker than previously and therefore the centres had a bit more room to work in, and this showed in Bob Nicholson's game, he had his best game since signing for us from Workington last season, and scored a great try. Although twenty minutes from the end of the game we were getting beaten 15 points to five we were playing just as well as Warrington and were gradually getting on top. At this stage Roy Wardale and Glyn Davies were injured and replaced by John Clough and Paul Kavanagh, and then for us the game really became alive Mel Mason started a move which Bob Nicholson finished off with his try and then another good move from both half backs ended with Phil Clegg scoring a good try near the posts Eddie Szymala kicked both goals to put us on level terms at 15 points each, then from just inside the Warrington 25 line Tony Dean completed a brilliant debut with an excellent drop goal to give us a well earned victory.

Perhaps now is the right time to welcome to Barrow both our new signing Mel Mason and Tony Dean and we are all quite sure that in the next few weeks and months they are going to brighten up all our games with their own brand of good rugby Mel has already got a job in Barrow and has bought a house in Devon Street and is due to move in with his wife and family this weekend, whilst Tony is still making up his mind whether to move to Barrow or not. Also playing for us at Warrington was Dave Seker who has been playing for Blackpool and Batley, he had an excellent game and played his full part in the victory. At the time of writing he has not signed for us but we hope that by the time this programme is published he will be a Barrow player. Their is better news of our injured players both John McFarlane and Phil Hogan see specialists this week and could be cleared to resume football, incidently Phil fancies going back to playing centre and seeing that he is probably the fastest player on the Barrow books he would certainly add speed and ability to our backs with Dave Seker filling the bill at loose forward, Ralph McConnell had a bad dose of the flu but should again be available for this game.

After a break of seven years the great Britain under 24 side makes it's re-appearance against France at Craven Park Hull to-day and we are represented in the match by Eddie Szymala who will be hooking for Great Britain. We offer Eddie our warmest congratulations on his selection and hope he has a good game to-day in what we also hope is the start of a long career in a Great Britain jersey.

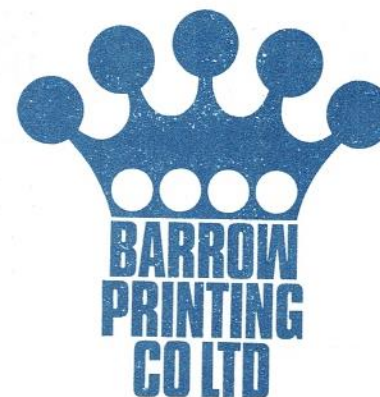

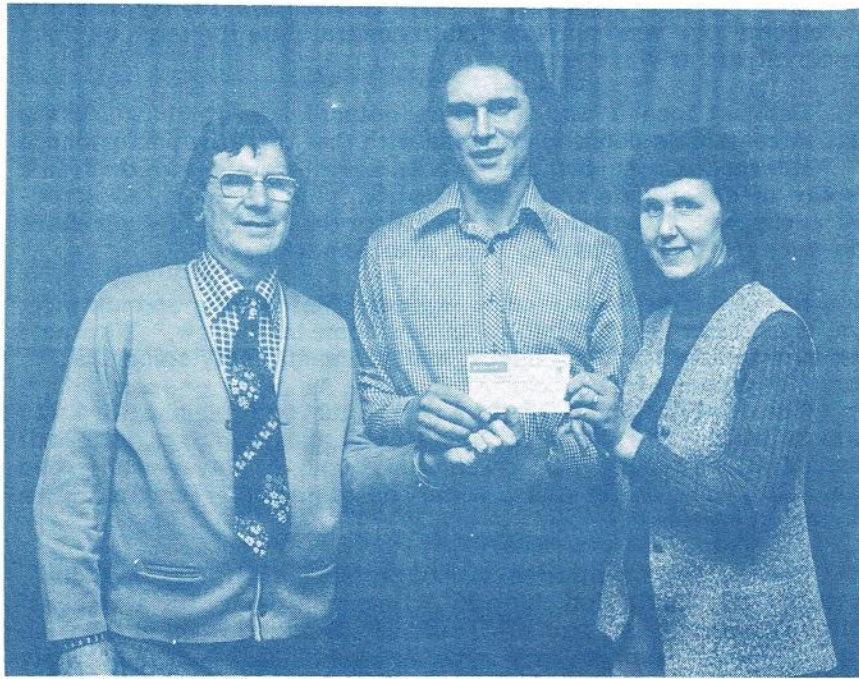
