## **OLDHAM OUTLOOK**

Our brand-new lottery, launched last week, surpassed all expectations with the first batch of 40,000 tickets sold out within four days.

Lottery chief Peter Mason would have been happy had he "sold out" within two weeks and to achieve the target within four days was absolutely staggering.

Immediately, he left for the Midlands to pick up the second batch of tickets several days ahead of schedule and opened talks with club chairman Ray Hatton about bringing forward from January plans to launch a second scheme to run alongside the present one.

The lottery launch took place on Wednesday of last week when hundreds of agents attended a big night out at Romeo and Juliet's.

Entertainment was provided by comedian George Roper and singer John Lavelle of "New Faces" fame, plus a disco and the club's resident band.

The first tickets in the lottery, which offers a top prize of £1,000 and total prize pay-out of nearly £3,500, were sold to George Roper and the new Oldham RL Queen, Miss Yvonne Bowden.

On Saturday the action switched to our new lottery office in Clegg Street when Stuart Hall, the television personality, and local beauty queen Janet Withey spearheaded a promotion and officially cut the tape that opened the offices as the hub of the operation.

They then went, with club officials, to a site on the Market at the top of Curzon Street where the club had a stand and two booths advertising and selling a lottery which could prove the biggest thing to happen to our club in years.

Despite the atrocious weather many people turned out to watch the operation which was voted a very definite hit by all those concerned.

By Monday the first batch of tickets were running out and Mr Mason left for the Midland to pick up the next lot to keep the impact going.

"We are absolutely delighted", he enthused. "We are almost sold out and there are a lot of outlets we have not yet got to".

Added Mr Hatton: "Even allowing for the fact that we had done our ground work, the lottery was received about ten times better than we had anticipated.

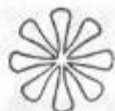
"It brought a smile to the treasurer's face which stretched from ear to ear".

## OUR VISITORS BY DON YATES

This afternoon's visitors to Watxsheddings are the vastly improved Blackpool Borough outfit who last week almost pulled off the shock result of the season when they led big spending Hull by 11-7 late in their game at the Boulevard. Unfortunately for Boro', the Airlie Birds were able to recover and snatch a late penalty try which gave them a rather fortunate 14-13 win but the Blackpool performance just indicates the current strength of their experienced line-up.

The team is led by scrum-half and coach Bak Diabira, a former Hull junior who was with Bradford Northern and New Hunslet before joining Boro' 12 months ago. The experienced Diabira has played three times for other Nationalities and he forms a dangerous half-back partnership with the former Leigh utility back Alan Fairhurst who was snapped up by the Seaside last February for £1,000. The versatile Fairhurst is Borough's leading try scorer this season with six touchdowns to his name and he is also a capable goal kicker, as is loose-forward Norman Turley, the former Warrington utility player. The most experienced section of the Blackpool line-up, however, must be the front row of the pack where Borough field former Workington Town and Cumbria prop Jimmy Hamilton, the fiery former Rochdale Hornets hooker Peter Clarke who a couple of years ago had a spell on loan at Watersheddings, and their most recent signing, Derek Watts who was bought last September from Workington Town for £2,000 after previous service with Leigh, Wigan and Huyton. 'We wanted so badly to win for one person - John Burke - so it has been a bitter disappointment for us to lose the trophy,' said Town's popular and dedicated director Tom Mitchell.

Now former chairman Tom, an experienced member of Council, is calling on everyone to support a fund they have launched.

'We feel that everyone in sport in the North - not just in Rugby League - should rally round and help us. We are hoping for a tremendous response,' he says.

I think, knowing the character and the good of the people who play, watch and help govern the Rugby League that they will be behind this appeal all the way.

I hope so for I cannot think of a more deserving cause.

## With the Amateurs ALAN BURKE

Last Sunday at Watersheddings, Saddleworth Rangers lifted the BARLA Lancashire--Cumbria Youth Cup for the second year in succession when they defeated Crosfields of Warrington in an excellent Final, played in atrocious conditions and for which both teams deserve credit. A penalty by Danny Cheetham and a Paddy Kirwan try in the closing minutes were enough to keep the trophy at Saddleworth, whilst a magnificent individual performance from captain Terry Flanagan gave him a fully deserved Man-of-the-Match award.

The majority of the successful Saddleworth youth team are on duty this afternoon representing the Oldham Amateur League's Under-18's town-team in their 1st Round match against Huddersfield in the BARLA Inter-League Youth Shield competition. Oldham should start as one of the favourites to take the title, and seemingly have a very good chance of at least progressing into Round 2. If the Oldham team do progress into the 2nd Round this afternoon, they should know their opponents by tonight as it is hoped that the draw will be given out on this evening's "Rugby League Special" programme on BBC Radio Manchester (6.15 pm.).

The Oldham League's open-age town-team went down by just 4 points to 0 in their Inter-League 1st Round game against Leeds a fortnight ago, whilst this afternoon at Hilton Park, Leigh, the BARLA Lancashire-Cumbria open-age Final is taking place between Leigh Miners Welfare and Crosfields, the winners of which will represent the amateur game on this side of the Pennines in the Rugby League Challenge Cup later in the season.

Next Saturday the two remaining 2nd Round matches will be played in this season's Oldham Standard Cup competition, which this season is celebrating its 75th anniversary. Ferranti are at home to Waterhead, and Saint Anne's entertain Salem Hornets, with the victors then joining Mayfield and Shaw in the semi-finals. The Final as usual will be played at Watersheddings on Good Friday morning (11 am.), and already the Oldham League have acquired sponsors for the match, programme, and match-ball. The Final itself is to be sponsored by Kegbro Construction Company of Broadbent Road, Oldham, the directors of which are Peter Brown and Kevin Geany, whilst the programme is being sponsored by Tommy O'Brien and Son, the building and demolition contractors of Thorpe Lane, Oldham. The match-ball is also being sponsored by a local firm, Len Hutton & Sons, the cleaning contractors of John Booth Street, Springhead.
