Bramley v Oldham — Sunday, 18th March 1979

OLDHAM

Year of formation — 1876.

Limited Company — Moves in season 1972-73 to make the club a limited company were out-voted by the members.

Former names of Club — Oldham Football Club from 1876-1971, when name was changed to Oldham Rugby League Football Club.

Former Grounds — Glodwick Lows from 1876 to date unknown; Clarksfield for unknown period; Watersheddings from 1889.

Club nickname — The Roughyeds.

Ground capacity — 18,500.

Record attendance — 28,000 v Huddersfield, February 24th, 1912.

Record victory — 67-7 v Liverpool City, April 1959.

Record defeat — 0-55 v Warrington, September 28th, 1948.

Highest scorer in one match — Bernard Ganley, 28 points v Liverpool City (April 1959).

Club try scoring record — Reg Farrar (49 in 1921-22).

Club goal scoring record — Bernard Ganley (224 in 1957-58).

Welcome to our friends from across the Pennines, Oldham; in fact, it's not often the two sides meet nowadays — this will be only the third league meeting between the clubs at Bramley since 1972. In 1972 they beat us here by 19 points to 5 after we had taken the honours at the Watersheddings in the early part of that season, winning by 30 points to 17. The other meeting was on February 10th, 1974, when Bramley won by 10 points to 7, with two tries from centre John Hughes and two goals from fullback Arthur Keegan.

We also welcome back to McLaren Field today our old friend Jimmy Fiddler. Jim made his debut for Oldham last weekend in the 22-5 home win over Huyton, and made the headlines with his powerful touch kicking, the try chances he made, and also his 5 goals; truly a great player and the man Bramley will have to watch if we are to get back on the winning trail.

Congratulations to Keith Waites and his wife, Lyn, on the birth of their baby boy. We wish them all the best.

We also take this opportunity to wish Blackpool Borough pack star, Jim Hamilton, a speedy recovery after unfortunately breaking his leg in the 34th minute of last week's game with Blackpool. To break a leg in the game which is your bread and butter is tragic; we wish him well.
