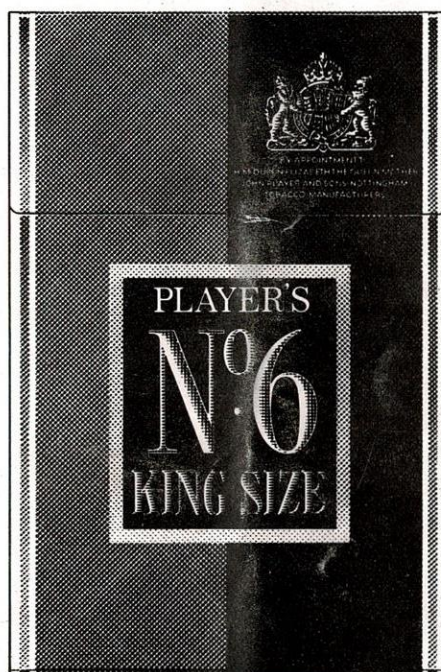

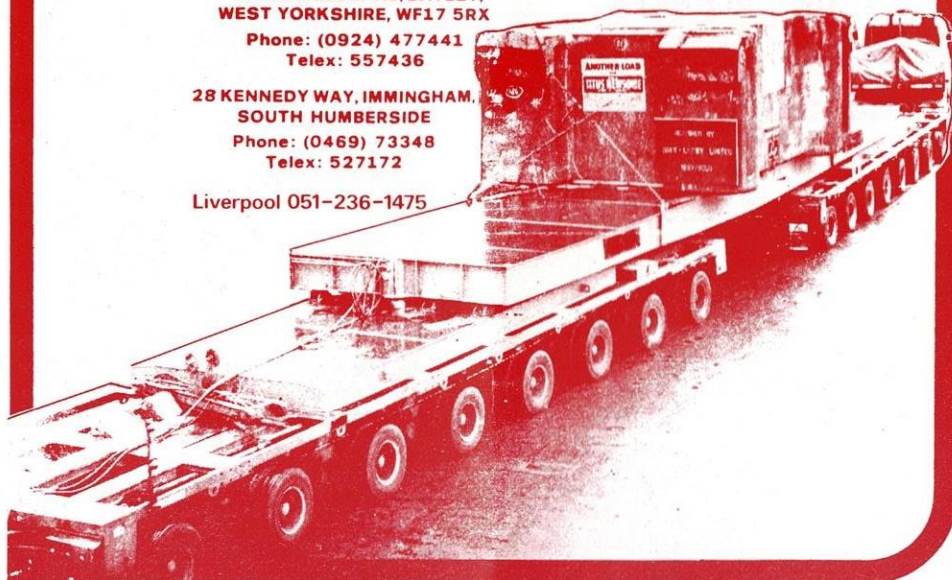

to give the fans something to cheer about, having openly praised the way people have been urging and cheering them on since the season started.

The club as a whole appreciates the backing that the Batley public and the Supporters' Club movement have been giving them. To reciprocate in the only way possible is now the main idea in the minds of all personnel — and it can be added that all that can possibly be done at this stage to attract further players is being done. This is in an effort to improve areas of under-strength in our play. It is a far from easy task, though, for the directorate to persuade suitable players to sign — as for instance in the case of Terry Hudson, who expressed the wish to join his former colleagues at Featherstone, even though we were prepared to pay the identical figure involved in the transfer market deal.

Those whose job it is to pursue every conceivable avenue of approach open to them will, however, continue to do just that; and although they could undoubtedly tell us of many unsuccessful attempts, it will only be when our self-styled "Mounties" get their man that we shall hear of it — and not, as in previous times, when a string of names or "hopeful signings" were treated by folk as just paper talk! The aim is to keep faith with the Batley people, and in return to hope that they will do the same for the club. No overnight miracle has been promised here at Mount Pleasant; long-term aims have. If implementation of those long-term aims fails to materialise, then people can claim to have been badly let down.

WE WELCOME THIS AFTERNOON'S VISITORS — OLDHAM R.L.F.C.

AS another club with a burning ambition to gain top ranking again, our friends from across the Pennines, Oldham, have got off to a reasonable start this season in their search for better things. Although beaten last week by Leeds at Watersheddings 31 - 7, Oldham only flagged in the latter stages of that game after being in contention up to the threequarters stage. Prior to their dismissal from the John Player Competition they had accounted for Swinton at Station Road in the Forshaw Lancashire Cup opening round 22 - 13 but lost the second round to Warrington 34 - 6. They bounced back with two consecutive league wins — over Doncaster (away) 25 - nil, and against Huyton 15 - 3 at home.

Last year major changes all round at the club saw Graham Starkey installed as new Manager, with his former position taken up on the signing of Bill Francis from Wigan, now Player-Coach. Our former half-back Terry Gorman also received a position with them as assistant team manager. Several of Oldham's players

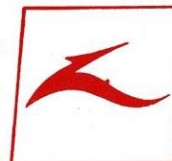

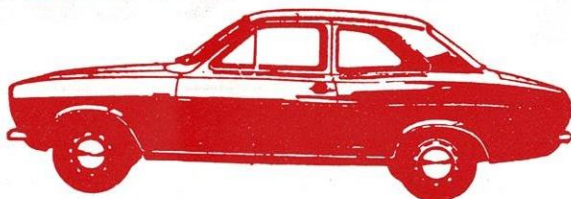

who have been the backbone of the side for numerous seasons have recently been put up for transfer, amongst whom is full-back Murphy, but, in addition to Francis, Oldham have also splashed out on Jim Fiddler (at around £7,000 from Leigh), while young Pitts, Bradford's reserve hooker, is on loan to them, and Phil Larder, their long-serving centre still continues to impress.

Oldham's second division record of last season was 10 victories, 1 drawn game and 15 defeats. They beat us at Oldham by 24 points to nil last year, but we won at home 19 - 5. Phil Ward (4 tries), Geoff Munro (3 tries) and Fiddler (12 placed kicks and 1 drop goal) are their leading scorers so far this season.

He concluded his run on the identical number of appearances as P. Jameson (August 1975 to November 1977).
