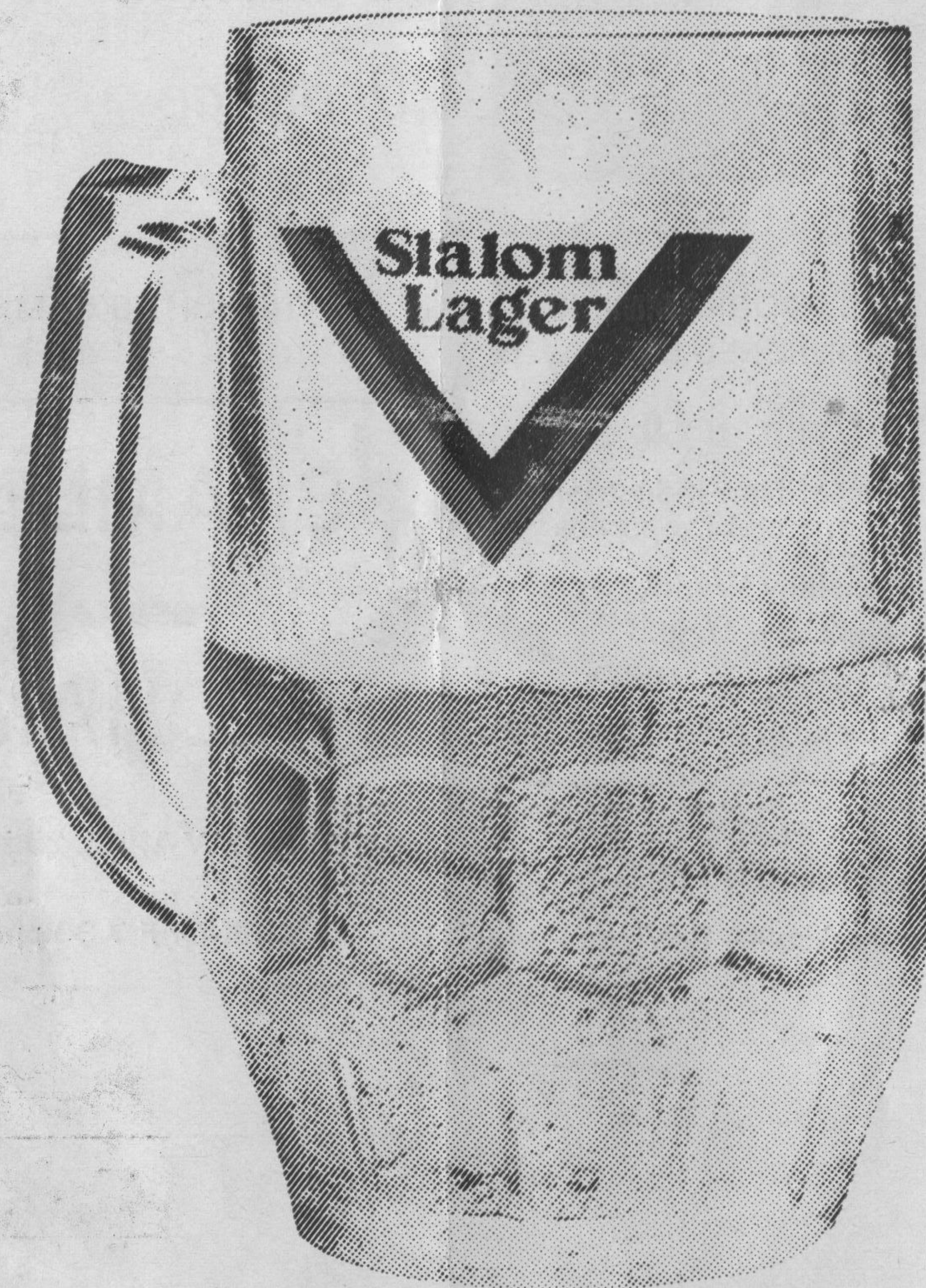

### CURTAIN-RAISER

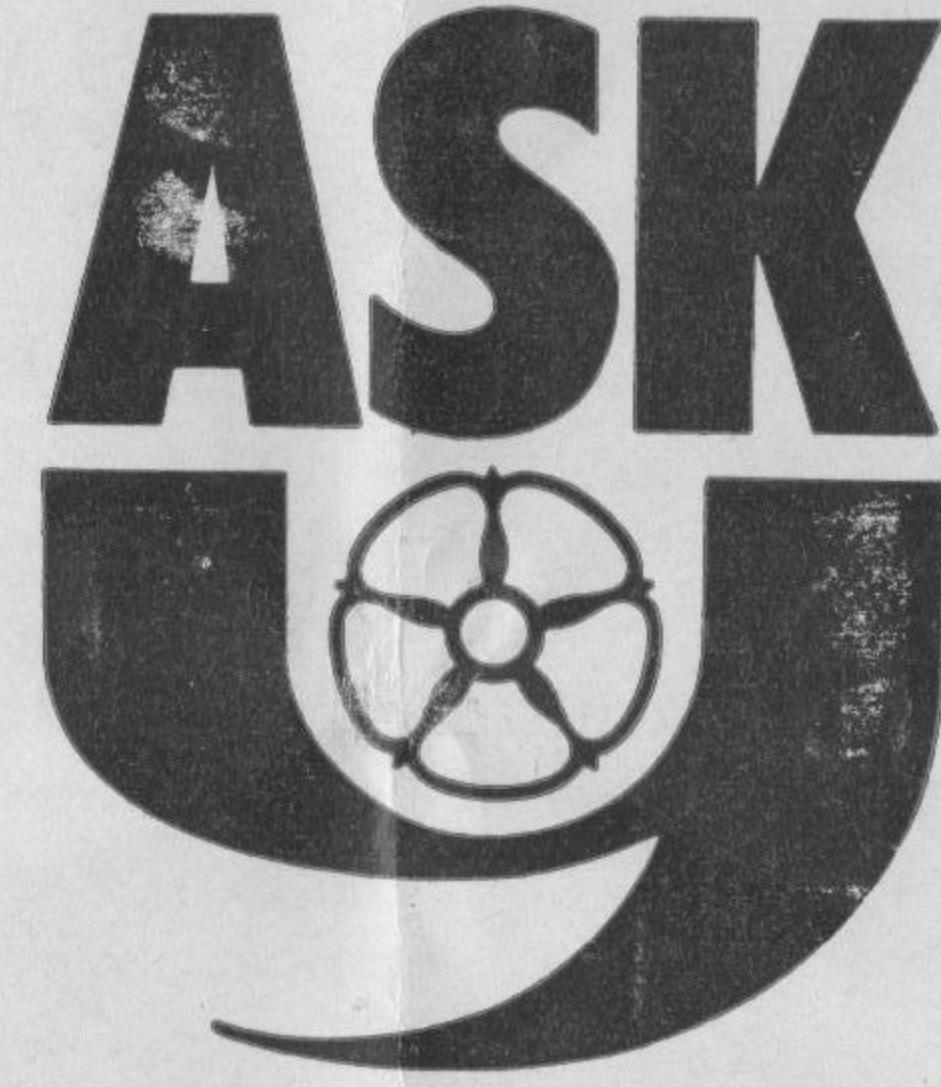

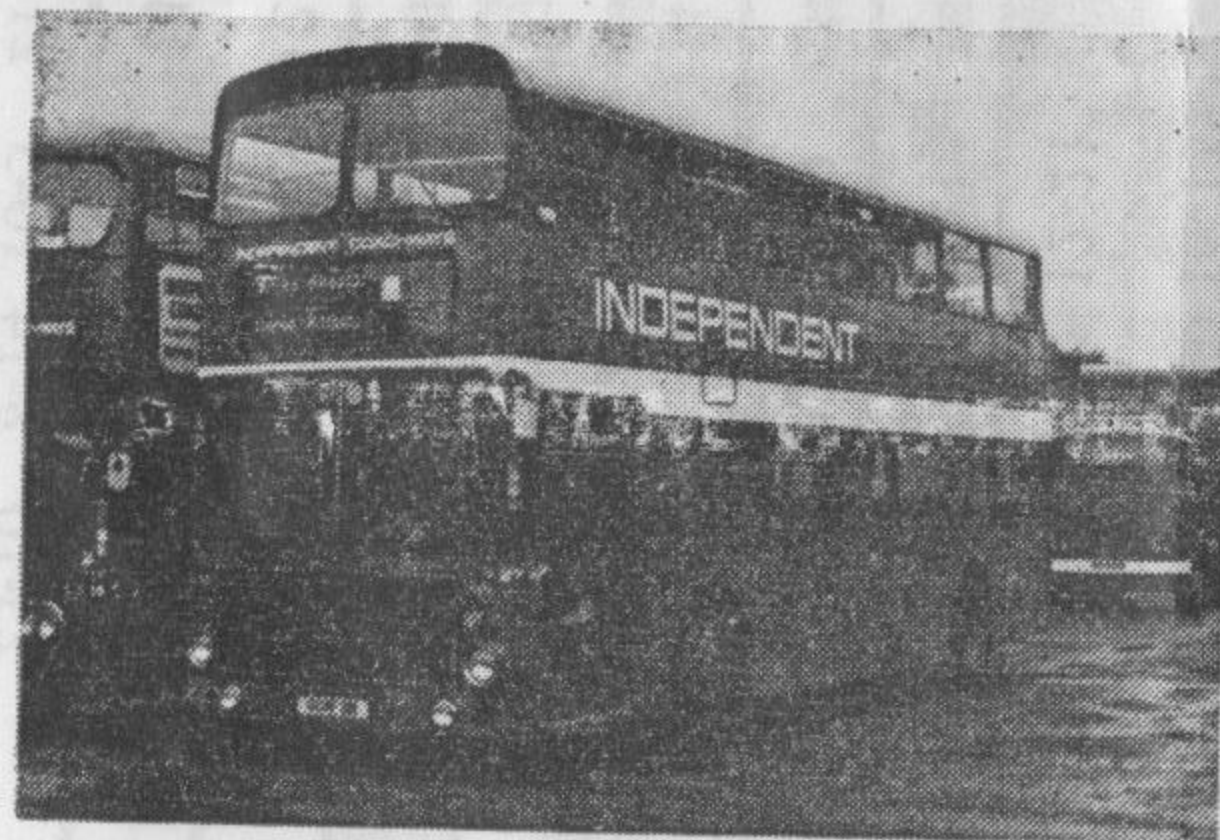

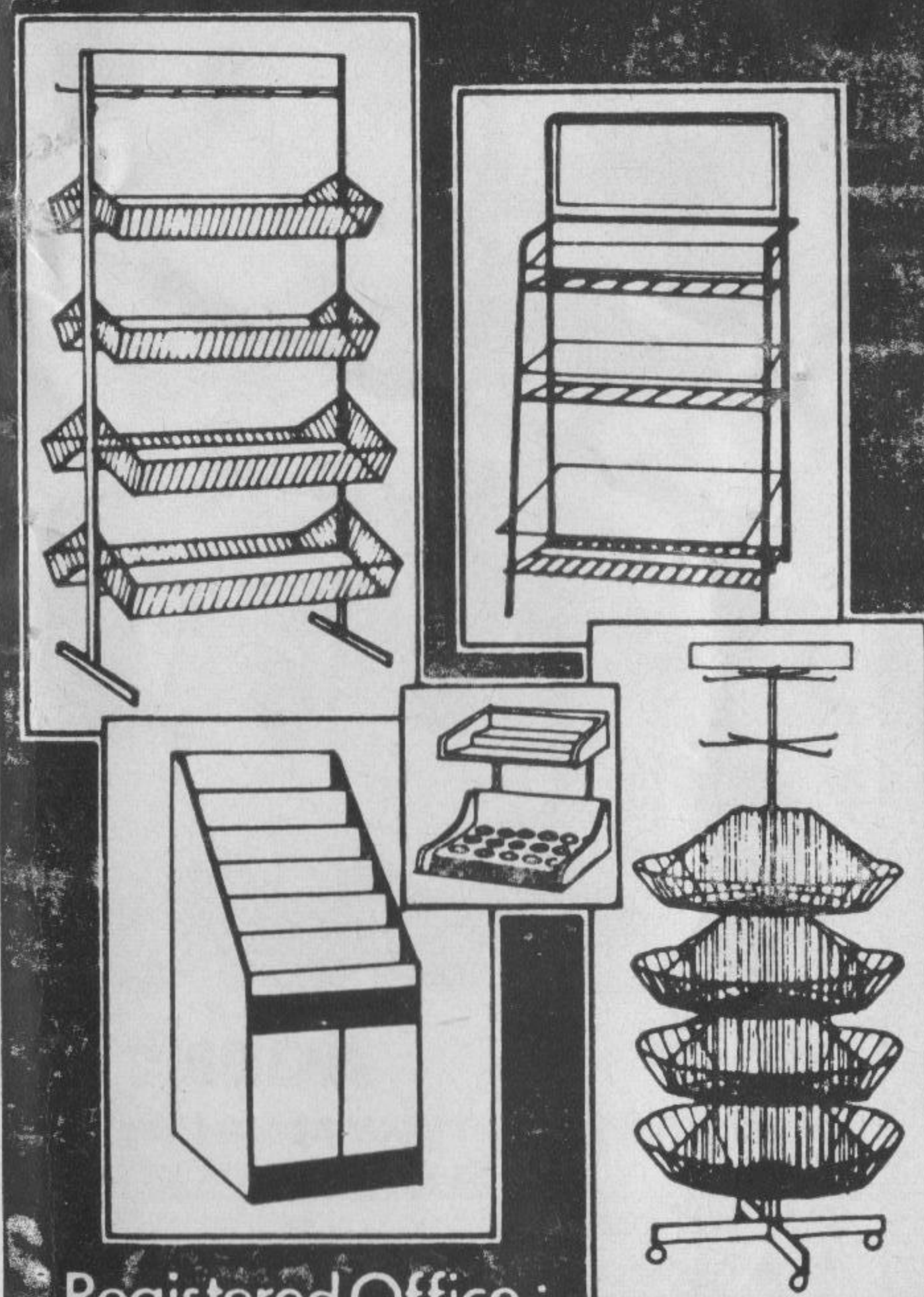

Rugby League referees are going to have to get together to straighten out one of the game's present problems. I feel it is time they tightened up a great deal on the play-the-ball situation. We seem to have slipped back to the bad old days in many respects leaving a blot on the game. You have only to study televised games to see how much this is spoiling the game's flow and presentation in many respects.

Some referees do clamp down regularly on offenders, but as a whole the position has deteriorated. We have players lying across the men they have tackled trying all sorts of tricks to prevent the ball being played quickly. The variations on this theme are considerable, but it all boils down to the same thing - a real mess that needs cleaning up.

A top club coach remarked to me recently: 'We have got to a pitch now where so many players are holding down opponents at the play-the-ball that it is becoming an accepted thing.' 'But it is preventing the chance to create moves quickly and bring slicker attacking - the action the game needs. 'There will be a real outcry when the Aussies arrive here on tour and see what is happening.'

'They will be completely justified if they protest. The Aussies have always made sure players are allowed to get up quickly and play the ball. 'It has kept their play speeded up and as a result they look slicker than our men. But if we are still in the same situation next season, then they will go out to exploit it. 'The Kiwis showed us how to handle it last time and I would have thought we would have learned from their tour.'
