They are currently doing their best to make it a short stay in the Division Two wilds and are currently top of the pile with seven wins and only one defeat (20-18 at Doncaster) from eight games.

Today we welcome Oldham highflyers who are shortly to take off as a fully fledged limited company when shares are launched.

We of course got a first hand look at the power of Eric Fitzsimons' lads with a 32-3 defeat at Watersheddings in the second game of this season. Keighley didn't deserve to go down so heavily that night after a bright opening half-hour.

Down the years honours have been almost even against the Lancastrians at Lawkholme with Keighley winning 13 and losing 15. The last time the clubs met in Division Two was in season 1981-82 when Oldham did the double (21-12 at home and 19-10 at Lawkholme) going up as champions.

The attendance that time at Lawkholme was over 2200, will we ever see the same or better again?

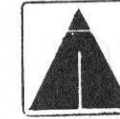

PLAYERS OT THE PAST - HARRY MYERS

Harry Myers was possibly the greatest Rugby player to play for the Keighley club, his career spanning the change from the Rugby Union to the Northern Union game.

Myers was born in 1875 and first played football when about 17 years old with an organisation named "Gragg Hill". He scored 9 tries in his first match and in the 1894/95 season, after going to watch a match between Horsforth and Newtown, he ended up playing for the Horsforth team in that match and for the rest of the season.

In the 1895/96 season he played with Bramley, gaining his first Yorkshire Cap against Durham at the age of 19 years. That season Yorkshire won the County Championship. When Bramley joined the Northern Union for the 1896/97 season. Myers joined Keighley and he was immediately elected Team Captain. Keighley won the Yorkshire Rugby Union Second Competition.

The following season Keighley finished third in the Yorkshire No. 1 Competition and on 5th February 1898 Harry Myers gained an International Cap, playing for England against Ireland at Richmond. The 1898 season saw Keighley improve their position to finish second and then a further improvement saw them winning the Yorkshire 1st Competition in the 1899/1900 season.

Up to this time Myers had played 20 times for Yorkshire as a Keighley player, to go with his 8 appearances whilst with Bramley.

In 1900 Keighley joined the Northern Union, finishing in second place in the Yorkshire 2nd Competition - Western Division. The following year they finished in 3rd place in the Yorkshire Senior Competition.

The 1902/03 season saw Keighley win their only major trophy since the change of Code when they were Champions of the Northern Union 2nd Division. In this season Myers made his only appearance in the Yorkshire Northern Union team.

All Keighley's success had been achieved in the career and under the captaincy of Harry Myers and although not quite as successful in the First Division the return to one division saw Keighley in the Semi-Finals of three competitions in the 1905/6 season. This was Harry Myers last full season and it saw Keighley in the Top 4 Play-off, Challenge Cup Semi-Finals and Yorkshire Cup Semi-Finals.

Harry Myers career, and life, ended in the following season. In the match against Dewsbury at Crown Flatt on 3rd November 1906 Harry Myers received injuries from which he died in Keighley's Victoria Hospital on 19th December 1906.

Harry Myers captained the Keighley team from the time he joined the Club until his death. He gained one International Cap and made 20 appearances in the Yorkshire Rugby Union team. He also played for the North against the South once and made one appearance for the Yorkshire Northern Union team. For Keighley he scored 87 tries and kicked 171 goals.

Keighley's most successful decade was overshadowed by the epresence of Harry Myers, a decade which was brought to an abrupt end by his death at the age of 31, at the hands of the game he loved.

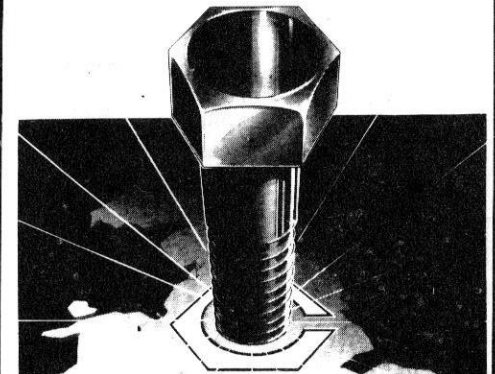

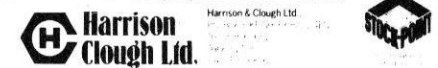

PAUL McDERMOTT

Paul McDermott needs one try for a career total of 100 touchdowns. His total is made up of 25 for Wakefield Trinity, 47 for York, 22 Sheffield Eagles, 4 Whitehaven and 1 Keighley.

McDermott began his professional career with Wakefield, joining them from their Colts side and making his senior debut as a back substitute when they lost 12-4 at Rochdale Hornets in a Division One match on 13th March 1977.

He had another three substitute appearances before his first full appearance when he played full-back in a 15-11 Division One home defeat of Warrington on 27th March 1978.

McDermott played several matches at full-back before moving to scrum-half and loose forward.

He has been involved in several transfers, moving back and forth between Wakefield, York and Sheffield in addition to a spell at Whitehaven and a two-match loan to Keighley.

His try total includes only two hat-tricks, one of them in Sheffield's first ever match when they beat Rochdale 29-10 on 2nd September 1984. His best season was 1980-81 when he finished fourth in the try chart with 23 for York. The only other occasion he finished in the Top Ten was when he was seventh with 22 for York in 1982-83.

ELLERY HANLEY

Ellery Hanley became only the fourth player to be selected and play in four different positions in a Test match for Great Britain when he played loose forward against Papua New Guinea at Wigan on Saturday.

He is the only one of the four to play in the pack. The Wigan star has also appeared at centre, stand-off and wing for Britain.

The other utility players are:

LEWIS JONES (Leeds) fullback, wing, centre and stand-off - 1954-57;

MICK SHOEBOTTOM (Leeds) fullback, stand-off, scrum-half and centre - 1968-71;

SHAUN EDWARDS (Wigan) stand-off, scrum-half, centre and fullback - 1985-87.

LEADING TRY SCORERS

Shaun Edwards of Wigan has taken over as the clear leading try scorer with 13 touchdowns. The stand-off has scored nine for Wigan, two for Lancashire and two for Great Britain.

He is followed by club colleague Ellery Hanley who has scored 12. Others with 10 or more are: Henderson Gill (Wigan), Des Drummond (Warrington), Martin Offiah (Widnes) 11 each; Mark Roberts (Warrington) 10.
