



That, however, can only be good for the club and the spectators.


We have an exciting season ahead of us and hopefully a successful one.

As last year we shall be taking each game as it comes and concentrate on winning.


It will be no different today, we won this competition last season and are determined to hold on to every piece of silverware . . . and get our hands on a few more for that matter.


#### **MEMBERSHIPS**




