

I'M told I came in for some severe criticism in the Guardian newspaper the other day following my reaction to the eight-match ban imposed by the Rugby League disciplinary committee on Leo Casey.

Paul Fitzpatrick, the Guardian writer, quoted me as saying that the Casey suspension was "ridiculous," and he then went on to criticise both Alex Murphy and myself for what he believed was our non-support of the so-called clean-up campaign.

I can't speak for Alex, but I can speak for Tony Barrow, and I want to make it clear that in principle I am all in favour of a disciplinary clamp-down.

The point about it all which I believed was "ridiculous" was in the comparison of the incidents involving Paul Moriarty of Widnes and Leo Casey of Oldham.

In the case of Casey, the Doncaster man with whom he was involved did not even leave the field.

In the case involving Moriarty, a Leeds forward well known to Oldham supporters, Hugh Waddell, suffered a broken jaw and Hugh has since been quoted as saying that he is considering seeking a civil action for loss of earnings during the time he will be

be out of the game injured.

I believe the punishment should fit the crime and for the life of my I cannot see how both Casey and Moriarty could receive the same length of suspension.

I am not necessarily saying that Casey's ban should have been less than eight matches, but I am certainly saying that if Casey warranted an eight-match ban then Moriarty should have been suspended for considerably more games.

Yes, let's clean up the game by all means, but let's make sure that each case is treated separately and that the punishments handed out really do fit the crime and stand the test of comparison.

Turning to the Oldham scene, we are really struggling at present under the pressure from a fearsome injury list which has decimated our pack.

I know that the lads who come into the side will play their hearts out and all we can do in the meantime is get on with the job to the best of our ability.

Injuries are part and parcel of the game and they afflict all clubs at some time or another.
