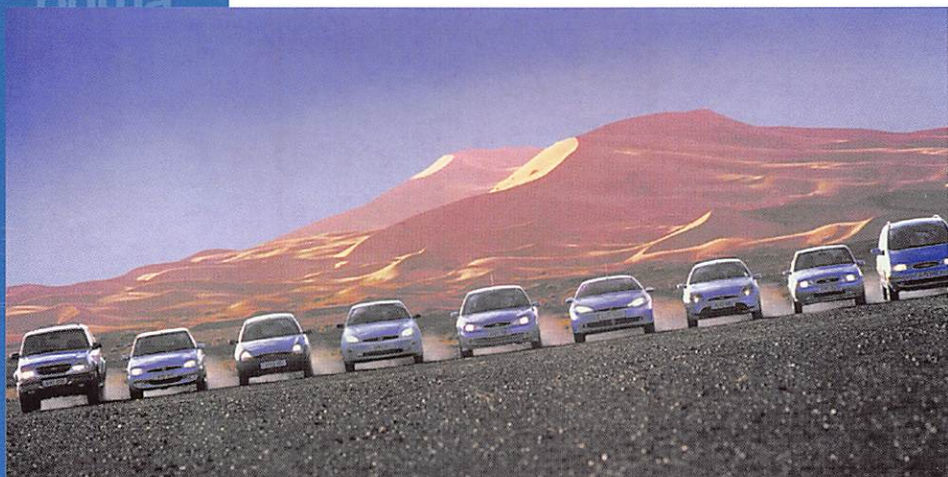

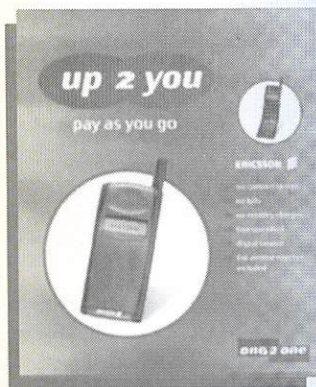

Pen Pictures of **Oldham Roughyeds**

AIDE MEAD Product of Oldham Bears Academy, this utility back is a handy member of the Roughyeds squad.

JOHN BOSTOCK Aussie three quarter, almost unstoppable near the try line. Surprisingly released by Wakefield Trinity, and a major capture for the Roughyeds.

AFI LEUILA Only member of the Bears Super League squad to join the "new" Oldham team. Of Tongan origin. Afi is a strong running three quarter who likes nothing better than to attack the opposition.

BRIAN QUINLAN Local born kicking centre or second row. Missed most of last season through injury.

MICK FARRELL 21 year old utility back, was outstanding for Rochdale in 1997 but had a disappointing 1998. The ex Waterhead amateur will be looking for a big season with his home town club.

JOE McNICHOLAS This young winger is one of the most exciting prospects in the new Premier Division. Having turned down Bradford Bulls, Joe was unfortunate to miss most of 98 after breaking his leg in the early season. Rochdale born, he is armed with pace and a great side step.

PAUL CROOK Half back who has previously played with Dewsbury, Oldham Bears and Hull Sharks. Creative player who is happy at either stand off or loose forward.

CRAIG BARKER Local half back or hooker who was not always a first choice in 98 but never lets the side down when selected.

LEO CASEY Now at the veteran stage, Leo has returned to Oldham in the close season. Has represented Ireland at International level. This tough prop forward was delighted to be named as Captain for this season's campaign.

JASON CLEGG Formerly a Bradford Bull, this prop has opened the season in barn storming form. Scored a typical rampaging try in the Law Cup against Rochdale. "Cleggy" is becoming a favourite with the Oldham spectators.

PAUL ROUND Now in his second spell with Oldham, Paul is a real veteran of the game. Formerly a back rower he now tends to lead from the front row. Former clubs include St Helens and Castleford.

DANIEL BROWN Australian half back or

hooker who played for Hull KR last season. Good play maker and also an extremely hard working tackler.

JOHN HOUGH John will go down in the "new" clubs history books as the first player to be officially sign for the Roughyeds. A bright future is predicted for this ex Warrington Wolves hooker who is renowned for his hard work and sportsmanship.

MARK PERRETT This Welsh international is another Roughyeds major close season signing. Mark is a hard working prop or second row who is determined to re start his career after injury.

GARY COULTER 29 year old former Huddersfield second row who has returned to the game after taking a spell away from it. His hard work and no nonsense attitude will be invaluable to the Roughyeds.

MIKE PRESCOTT Another player who will be determined to have a good season after last season was weakened through injury. Mike is a deceptively quick back row forward.

MICK MARTINDALE A good ball playing loose forward, 24 year old Mick was at Halifax for a number of years before joining his hometown club via Wakefield Trinity.

EMMERSON JACKMAN A BARLA tourist in the summer of 1998 this eye catching stand off or loose forward established his reputation at Saddleworth rangers and Oldham St Annes.

NATHAN VARLEY Started most games from the subs bench last season but was still one of the clubs top tacklers. This ex Bradford back rower has had his pre season ruined by an ankle injury picked up on New Years Day at Rochdale.

GRAEME SHAW Hard working back row forward, signed from Bradford Bulls. The "new" clubs first International in October 1998 playing for Scotland.

LAURENT MINUT French full back signed from Villeneuve. Courageous tackler and good under a high ball. Known as "Mins" to his team mates.

EMMANUEL PERALTA Came to Oldham with his team mate Laurents "Mins". Is no stranger to England having previously played for Keighley.

Well - you can certainly say the past two weeks have been eventful. Since our home game with Batley we have lost the services of two important members of our first team squad. Firstly Gary Schofield has decided to terminate his contract with the club, with immediate effect. This

decision has been made by Gary for personal reasons and he has spoken to me on a number of occasions to make it clear that his decision has not been made because of problems with the coaching or playing staff and he leaves with the best wishes for the future from everyone

connected with the playing staff. Secondly, Steve Watene, our recent signing from Wakefield Wildcats has had to return home to Australia because his father has a serious illness. Steve was just settling in quite nicely with the club but obviously his personal life and family well being must come first - our thoughts are with him at this time and our best wishes are also sent to the rest of his family.

At the time of writing this column, due to print deadlines, I am unable to give you definite names of any new faces that could be joining the

club, but you can be assured that every effort is being made to bring the squad back up to strength.

Looking at the past results from a coaching point of view it has been very frustrating because the side has been good enough to beat the likes of Batley and Rochdale, but a number of simple mistakes have cost us dearly.

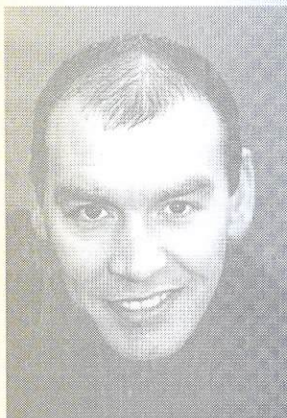
We have proved as a squad that we are good enough to compete with these sides, but we must play "smart football" for the whole eighty minutes and keep our concentration levels high.

The Premiership has proved in the early stages of the season that the teams are very

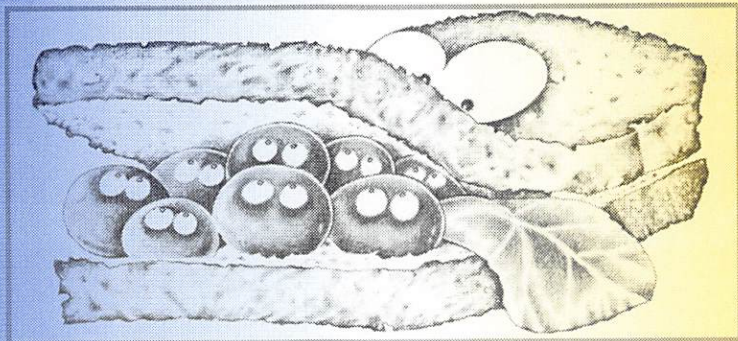
evenly matched and results have shown that this is not a one horse race.

50 YEARS OF RL STORIES



Step back in time with some of the stories covered over the past 50 years

1951 FEB 24 - 'SWINTON HOPES'

Swinton fans should note that Ralph Morgan holds a unique record. In his last five games he has kicked four or more goals - on one occasion five! That wants some doing and fans hope the ex-Carfax policeman will keep up this rate of scoring.

1959 FEB 20 - 'A BONUS TO PLAYERS'

At a recent meeting of Featherstone Rovers Supporters' Club the question of bonuses to players for League matches was strongly debated, and the outcome was that every effort be made to stop clubs doing this. The points against are:
i) That only the top clubs can offer such bonuses.
ii) It creates 'win at any price' methods of play.
iii) Players of clubs who cannot afford such bonuses become discontented and unsettled.
iv) It is killing the real spirit of the game and creating unfair competition.

1962 FEB 23 - 'UNBEATABLE RECORD'

Will Rosenfield's record of 80 tries in a season ever be beaten? Certainly not this year. Vollenhoven and Boston, who are heading the list at present, would have to add their totals of 32 and 30 together to get near the figure. 'Rotzy' had reached at this stage of his record breaking 1913-14 season.

There has been a lot of sympathy for Peter Fox following the news that his contract as Bradford Northern coach will not be renewed at the end of the season. The news brought expressions of shock and disappointment from both the dressing room and the terraces. Skipper Jeff Grayson said he was 'stunned' and there was much support for Fox on a local radio phone-in. A statement by the Bradford club they had taken the decision in the best interests of everyone concerned, and that it was time for a 'clean sweep' and a change in the traditional style of play.

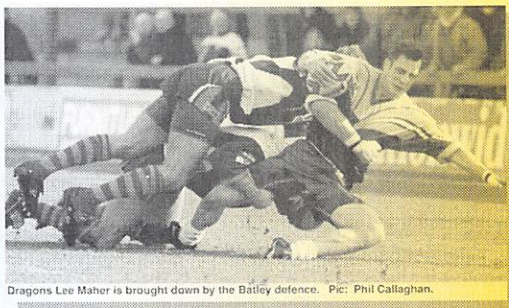

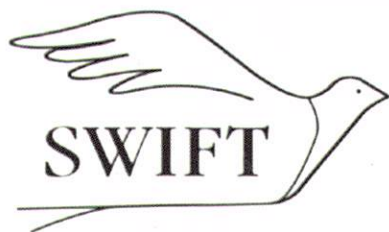
