## Views from the North

Alan Tucker



This afternoon we welcome the players, fans and officials of Oldham. They're a place above us in the league and as at last weekend, three points ahead. This is a match we desperately need to win if we are to make any headway on the group hovering around the fringes of the top nine.

It won't be easy, as Oldham will be full of confidence after their surprisingly heavy defeat of Whitehaven last weekend. We shouldn't be short of confidence either after our 48-4 win over Swinton. A win incidentally, that despite a fine afternoon and no compelling World Cup matches on the box attracted a dismally low crowd of 670.

I thought our performance, especially our defence, was as good as anything we've played this year. Cliff Beverley and Iain Marsh (on off the sub's bench for the concussed Shane Irabor) each scored hat tricks. A brace from Radney Bowker, one from non-stop hooker Andy Henderson and six goals from Darren Holt completed the route to give Barrow a 48-4 victory and hopefully attract back some of the stay-away fans.

The real dampener on the proceedings occurred mid-week when Dave Clark, back after a fourteen-month absence with knee reconstruction, suffered a hamstring injury. Time will tell how long he takes to recover but the experts are predicting between three and eight weeks. We all wish him a speedy recovery.

Elsewhere in the game, Saints were superb in the way their patched up team so ably disposed of Leeds at Headingley. They put their narrow scrappy victory over Salford well behind them in a comprehensive defeat of the Yorkshire men.

Not a bad weekend with England beating Argentina, our Academy lads hammering Workington, animal Mike Tyson being dumped

by our own Lennox Lewis and two West-of-the-Pennines Superleague teams beating Yorkshire's finest. Not to mention our own victory.

Away from the action for a moment to events off the field. On the face of it, the proposal to split the NFP into two divisions based on merit has much to recommend it theoretically. You give more clubs promotion / relegation issues to fight and keep the interest going right to the end of the season.

As usual, the devil is in the detail. In many areas of the NFP the game is in too fragile a state to endure the lower gate revenue deriving from this if they are in the lowest division. With negligible central finance, I can foresee other clubs following York and yielding to the financial odds stacked against them.

As clubs don't choose to go out of existence at a convenient time in the closed-season, I fear a major embarrassment to the game with a number of clubs in the lower division failing to complete their season.

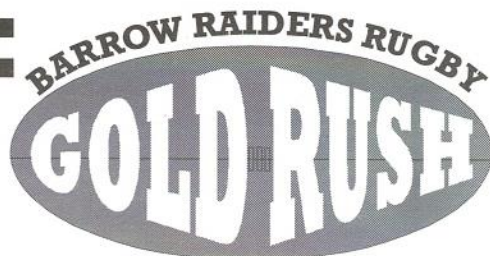

The game needs a couple of years of good financial governance to establish central funding for the NFP to cure some of its ills before the radical operation of restructuring into two divisions can be successfully achieved.

## OLDHAM

Pen Pics...

**Gareth Barber** 20 year old Oldham born half back or centre who was reared on rugby with his best pal, the Leeds and Great Britain loose forward, Kevin Sinfield. When Sinfield signed for Leeds Rhinos, Barber signed for Warrington, but returned home to Oldham before the start of the 2000 - 2001 season. Played for the NFP Under 21's at Widnes in the autumn.

**John Braddish** Signed from St. Helens on long term loan. Top goal kicker in the Alliance Championship last season and also leading points scorer in that same competition. Wanted a change of club because of limited senior opportunities at Knowsley Road and he turned down several other offers to join Oldham where he is developing his half back skills.

**Keith Brennan** A versatile half back or hooker. Local lad Keith shot to prominence last season when his form was so good that, for a time, he kept John Hough out of the No.9 shirt. A natural footballer with good hands, he damaged a hamstring in the pre-season Law Cup game with Rochdale and then damaged a knee in his come-back game in the Cup against St. Helens.

**Chris Campbell** A recently signed 21 year old utility back, signed from Whitehaven after impressing in trials. Is the son of ex referee David Campbell. Signed for Warrington from Crossfields amateur club as a seventeen year old and was the top Alliance try scorer in his first season with 26 tries from full back. Played 10 matches in Super League before following coach Paul Cullen to Whitehaven on a full time contract. Unfortunately broke his jaw early in his Whitehaven career.

**Jason Clegg** Second biggest forward at the club after Danny Guest, is a former Bradford (Northern, not Bulls) forward, who has had four good seasons with Oldham. Powerful on the break, he is a favourite of the Oldham supporters and regularly picks up the Junior Roughyeds Player of the Year Award.

**Will Cowell** A 21 year old who played at Warrington, this Cumbrian utility back is equally at home at full back wing or centre. Played 18 Super League games for Warrington after signing from Kells, the Whitehaven amateur club. Recommended to Oldham by former Wolves boss, Daryl van de Velde, Will is keen to kick start his career in the NFP with the Roughyeds.

**Gavin Dodd** A local youngster who is learning the ropes at Oldham. A wing or full back, 20 year old Gavin played for the NFP Under 21's at Widnes and is sure to be pushing for a regular place this season, either as competition for Mark Sibson at full back or as a lively winger who knows where the try (goal) line is.

**Lee Doran** Another young player in whom Oldham have a lot of confidence. A Wiganer, Lee has worked his way through the Oldham Academy and Alliance sides and is now on the verge of breaking through to the first team on a regular basis. Showed up well for the NFP Under 21's as one of five Roughyeds players in the squad.

**Phil Farrell** The 'other' Oldham captain in a new move that former boss Ford believed would work well to the benefit of the whole squad. Phil, younger brother of Wigan and GB ace Andy Farrell, didn't miss a match last season and in his two seasons with the club, has a remarkable record of consistency. Played for the NFP Under 21's against their Super League counterparts.

**Anthony Gibbons** Formed a reliable centre partnership last season with goal kicking Pat Rich, who has now left the club to go on a twelve months world tour. Looked certain to be the first-choice centre again this season, but suspension and a bad ankle injury have meant he has missed the start of the season.

**David Gibbons** Anthony's identical twin. The brothers have moved around together throughout their rugby league careers with Leeds, Bramley, and now Oldham. Vice captain last season, stand off, David, has been appointed one of TWO Oldham captains this term and is sure to be one of Oldham's leading lights.

**Jon Goddard** A 19 year old and the youngest member of the squad, Cas. lad Jon has joined Oldham on loan from Castleford thanks to the old pals act. Graham Steadman is a firm friend and former team mate of former coach, Ford and saw a loan spell with Oldham as the ideal way to bring Jon along. Already this is bearing fruit as Goddard's defence has been superb and as his confidence grows it is expected that the tries will soon be coming.

**Danny Guest** Another of the Roughyed 'originals' who returned to the club two seasons ago. A big prop, he is expected to be a force to be reckoned with in the NFP this season after signing a new one year deal.

**Bryan Henare** Joined Oldham midway through last season from St. Helens on loan. A Kiwi back-rower who has played for Auckland Warriors, Bryan played a prominent role in Oldham's surge to the Grand Final in July 2001 before signing permanently for the club for the 2002 season on a one year contract.

**John Hough** The first player to sign for his home town club when the new Roughyeds were formed by Chris Hamilton and his fellow directors in the autumn of 1997. Before the start of the season, he had played 87 of the club's 90 matches and had scored 32 tries, a phenomenal record for a hooker. He didn't enjoy one of his better seasons in 2001, but a change of job, and less travelling has seen him back at his best in 2002.

**Gavin Johnson** A young centre or wing, or occasional back row forward. Oldhamer, Gavin spent two seasons at Odsal in the Bradford Academy side and made the occasional appearance for the Bulls in the Alliance Championship. Spent almost a season earning his Oldham spurs in the Alliance team before signing a two year deal last September.

**Joe McNicholas** One of the original 1997 roughyeds, wingman Joe made a first team spot his own midway through last season and went on to score eight tries in 14 consecutive appearances. Fast off the mark, good on his feet and always gives 110%.

**Steve Molloy** A recent signing. Steve has been playing for Batley on a short term contract after leaving Huddersfield at the end of last season. A strong prop forward and ex captain of England, Steve's other previous clubs are Featherstone and Sheffield. A local lad, Steve will go some way to filling the gap left by Simon Knox and Leo Casey.

**Anthony Murray** Another recent signing from Swinton. Anthony is a versatile player who can play hooker, half back or loose forward. Unfortunately he injured a knee in his first game for the club against Sheffield.

**Paul Norton** Journeyman forward and former Lancashire Lynx stalwart who played in 31 of 34 games last season. A hard worker and value for money performer, 'Knocker' was sorely missed at the start of the season when he was recovering from a groin operation.

**Neil Roden** A clever half back who joined Oldham from Wigan, with Farrell, a season and a half ago. Has only missed a couple of games since. Can play stand off or scrum half and was a key figure in Oldham's run through to the NFP Grand Final last summer. A knee injury kept him out of the pre-season warm-up games, but he is sure to be a regular performer in the long and testing 2002 campaign.

**Mark Sibson** Quick full back who loves nothing better than to attack from deep. Joined Oldham on a two year contract when he left Bramley at the same time as former boss Mike Ford, the Gibbons twins and Andy Proctor and has recently signed a new one year deal.

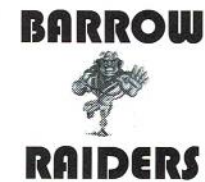
