MANLY WARRINGAH DIRFL - A BRIEF HISTORY

Manly had the distinction of the first place within Port Jackson to be named by captain Arthur Phillip when he encountered some natives of "confidence and manly bearing" on January 21, 1788. It wasn't until the early 1900s, however, that the relative isolation of Manly was overcome with the introduction of trams and ferries. The population then began to grow steadily.

Although Rugby Union in the Manly District can be traced back to the 1870s, competitive Rugby League was not introduced to the peninsula until 1932. During a 75 minute meeting in the barber shop of the first Junior League president, Harry Bones, the Manly and Warringah Junior Rugby Football League was born with a six team A grade and five team B grade competition.

The Junior League were initially governed by the North Sydney district and supplied many players to their senior ranks, but for many years lobbied for recognition as a district club which was granted in 1947 following Manly winning the President's Cup in 1946.

Both the senior and the junior clubs have enjoyed success ever since. Manly Warringah has grown to be one of the most successful clubs of the modern era and has boasted in its ranks 25 local juniors who have represented Australia. The highest number of any junior league in Sydney.

MANLY WARRINGAH DJRFL - A GRADE REP TEAM

The "A Grade" representative team is selected annually from teams competing in the district's open age competition and plays against equivalent teams from other districts. Each year, the team plays against South Sydney and St George A grade teams as part of an inter-district challenge and has also played Lebanon and Country divisional teams in recent years. The team is a blend of youth and experience and boasts a number of players who are on the cusp of NRL and Premier league football.

This inaugural UK tour is part of a development and appreciation program for players in the local international rules competitions. Funds are being raised to provide development programs, trips away, coaching seminars and infrastructure.

This tour provides a great opportunity for the squad to experience the game in its birthplace and to make and enjoy friendships with not only Manly players but also UK based players. Each squad member has paid and worked for the honour of representing his district and for the rugby league experience of a life time.
