"No-one was more frustrated than me at last week's game against Blackpool being cancelled. This followed up Wakefield's decision to pull out of our scheduled friendly at Belle Vue. The Blackpool decision was the right one, the pitch was unplayable, but we wanted to go to London with 3 games under our belts, instead we will just have two.



Halifax RLFC Football Manager and Director Paul Dixon shares his thoughts on the recent weekend away in Newcastle.

"Faz made it clear what the objectives of the weekend were and without being boring, I would say that we met them."

"26 players in total went up to Newcastle, 8 of them from the under 21s. After arriving on Friday, we had a really good meeting where we set out the goals for the year. In addition we outlined the patterns of play, structures and plays. This gave us a base for training for the next 2 days".

"All of the boys including the new ones, got a say and it was pleasing that a number of the younger lads gave their opinions on how things should go on the field"

"Friday Night saw us go out as a group to what was described as a Comedy Club, although the word comedy was taking things a bit far."

Saturday saw us training in the morning on a field near Gosforth. The weather was bitterly cold and the pitch frozen in places, but we got in 2 hours of quality which focused on the plays, structures and patterns that we talked about the previous night.

Saturday Afternoon saw us paint-balling which the boys enjoyed. Some boys came in for some treatment more than others. I'll leave you to decide on who they were. Tea-time saw us discuss what happened on training with adjustments made with all of the lads having their say. The meetings were very constructive with plenty of ideas aired and exchanged"

"Saturday Night saw the boys go out into town while Sunday Morning saw the boys train for another 2 hours. The session consisted of ballwork and fitness with lots of emphasis on ballwork, and in particular game related situations. Sunday Afternoon saw us coming home."

"The weekend has brought the players closer together and got the lads to know me, Faz, Scotty and Karl (Fairbank) better. Just as importantly, we have outlined our goals for the year and put in place, plays, patterns and structures for us to take into training and onto the field of play"

"The only disappointments of the weekend were the weather which was bitterly cold and a twisted ankle picked up by Ben Fisher in training. We'll let the physio assess Ben tonight but it will be touch n go if he plays on Sunday, while James Bunyan is unlikely to feature also. Aside from that, we'll have a clean bill of health for Oldham".

"The boys have come back in great form and can't wait to get into action".
