Those that made the journey to North Wales this past weekend would have witnessed some great attacking flair, and some excellent tries, but the performance wasn't only about attack. I felt, certainly during the first half, that our defence was excellent overall and gave us the confidence to really take the game to the Crusaders on their own turf.



Its worth remembering that only a week before hosting ourselves, Crusaders knocked Toulouse out of the Challenge Cup and despite a slip up away in the capital, they had been in pole

In good news, I expect to pick from the 17 that played in Wales last weekend, with Danny Davies, Tony Stewart, Ste Lucas, Dean Gorton and Paul Crook all there or thereabouts when it comes to my final team selection.





# RUGBY LEAGUE WORLD CUP FIXTURES

The Rugby League World Cup 2013 today announced the group games and quarter final matches for the tournament. The tournament will kick off at the Millennium Stadium in Cardiff with a double header as Wales play Italy in the curtain raiser for England v Australia. But all eyes in the first round of games will be on Rochdale as Hornets will host Fiji v Ireland. Indeed, it's already capturing the media's attention.

Today's Guardian Sport said of the game at Spotland: "That may sound an unlikely and uninspiring location but it actually makes a fair bit of sense, as Rochdale has had a thriving Fijian community since a number of trailblazers came to play for the town's rugby league club in the early 1960s

FijiBati.com, official website of the Fiji National Rugby League says: "There has been a long history of Fijian players making their mark in rugby league, most notably back in the 1960s when great players such as Joe Levula and Laitia Ravouvou joined Rochdale Hornets and became household names in the English competition."

Certainly, Rochdale will feel like Suva for a day as the town's RL fans become temporary Fijians and celebrate the massive contribution that Fiji has made to the town's sporting culture.

England v Australia — Millennium Stadium, Cardiff\*;
Fiji v Ireland — Spotland Stadium, Rochdale;
England v Ireland — the Galpharm Stadium, Huddersfield; Australia v Fiji — Langtree Park, St Helens; England v Fiji — KC Stadium, Hull; Australia v Ireland — Thomond Park Stadium, Limerick.





Every attendee will be invited onto the pitch at half time to receive their certificate.


Today we will also have three teams competing for the Spotland Curtain Raiser Cup prior to the game.


