It's nice to win games but sometimes it's how you win them which is more rewarding and working as hard as we did in offence & defence makes the taste of victory sweeter.

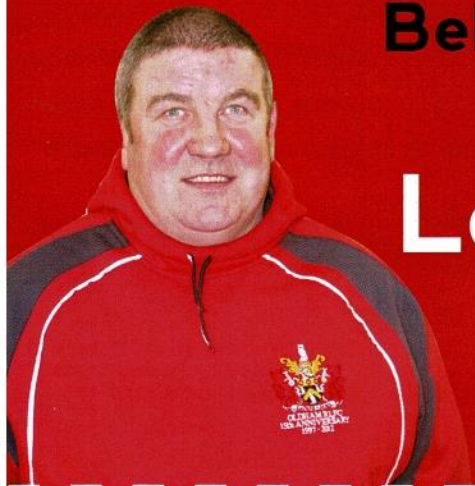

WELL, a lot can change in the space of a week!

After the disappointment of the result at North Wales the team did us proud with a display against Rochdale that left me wondering how long ago it was since we dominated and controlled a game so much.

Not that anybody within the camp was too downbeat after the trip to Wrexham - it was more a case of wanting to put things right, as we undoubtedly have a committed and determined bunch of players and coaching staff at the club. The pride in performance was there for all to see last week.

First of all though we will be doing our best to get three more Northern Rail cup points today and you, as always, have your part to play. Get behind the lads and make as much noise as you can - it does make a difference!

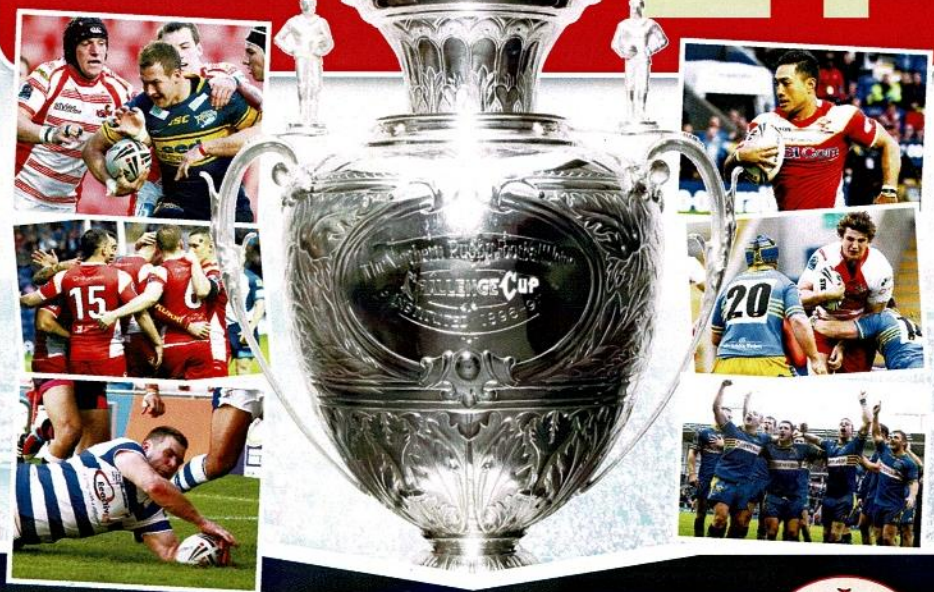

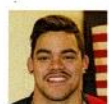

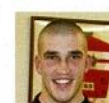
