**Age:** 24 **Position:** Winger

One of the best finishers around at this level and has shown that again this season, recording 17 tries in 19 appearances including a double in the match against Oxford at Whitebank back in June.

### DANNY LANGTREE



**Age:** 24 **Position:** Second-row Forward

Arguably one of the stand out players in League 1 last year given the number of accolades he was given. Langtree has continued his fine form in 2015 scoring 12 tries in 22 appearances. Langtree is a second rower who was a former St Helens Junior and spent his first two seasons in the reserves but he became an immediate first team regular on Scott Naylor's arrival for the start of the 2013 campaign. Since then he has played in 70 of a possible 75 games, scoring 36 tries.

If you allow him to, Palfrey could manage a game on his own with his infield kicking game. He is handy both with the boot and chipping in with tries and has 11 to his name this season, and is an ever present member of the squad and captain of the side.

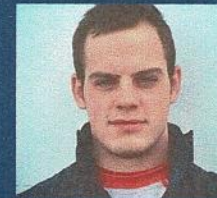

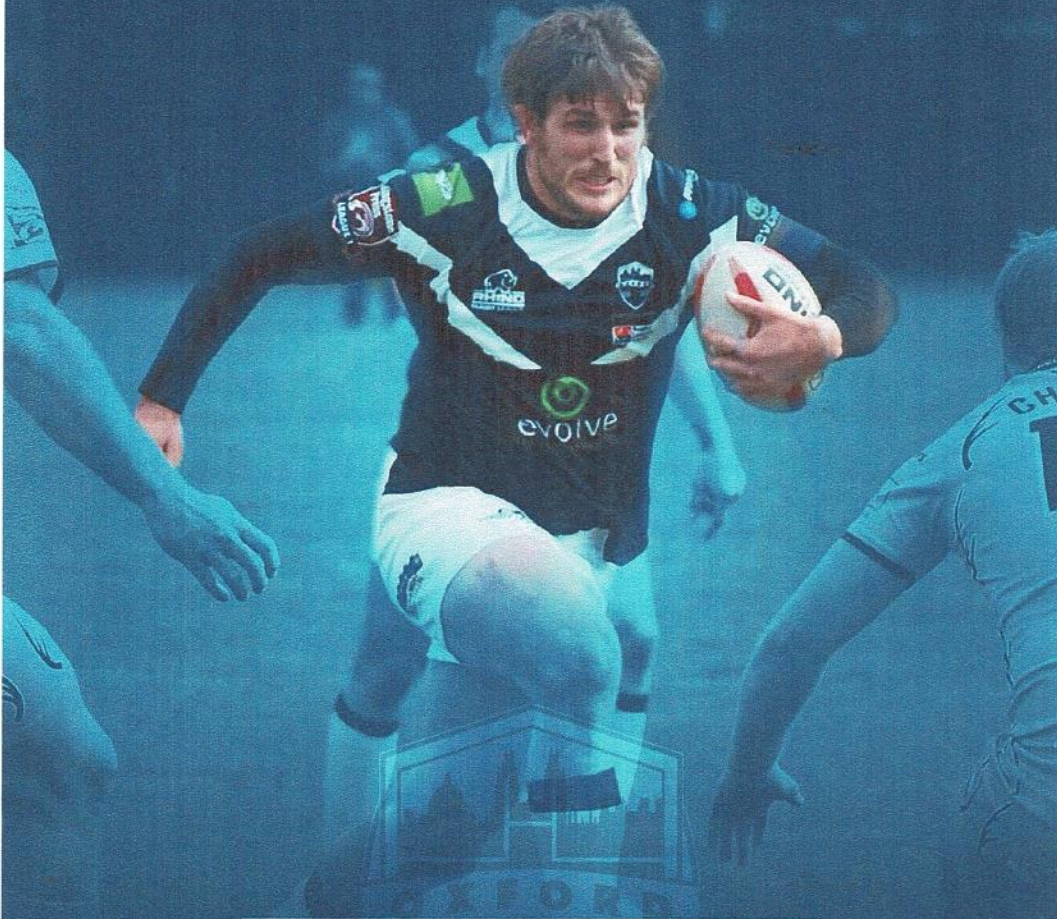

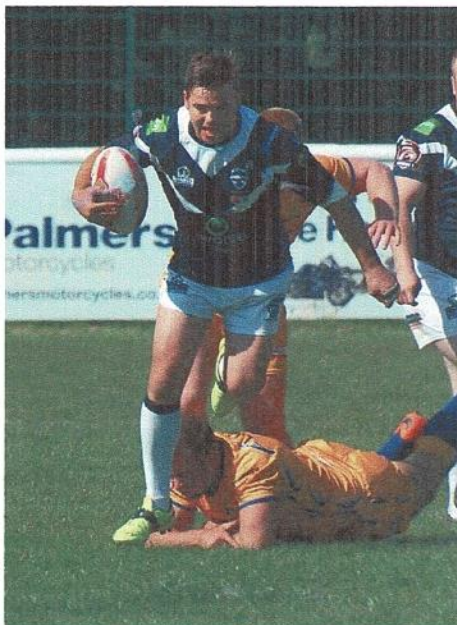

**Louis Richards** - When Harry Kaufman smiled.

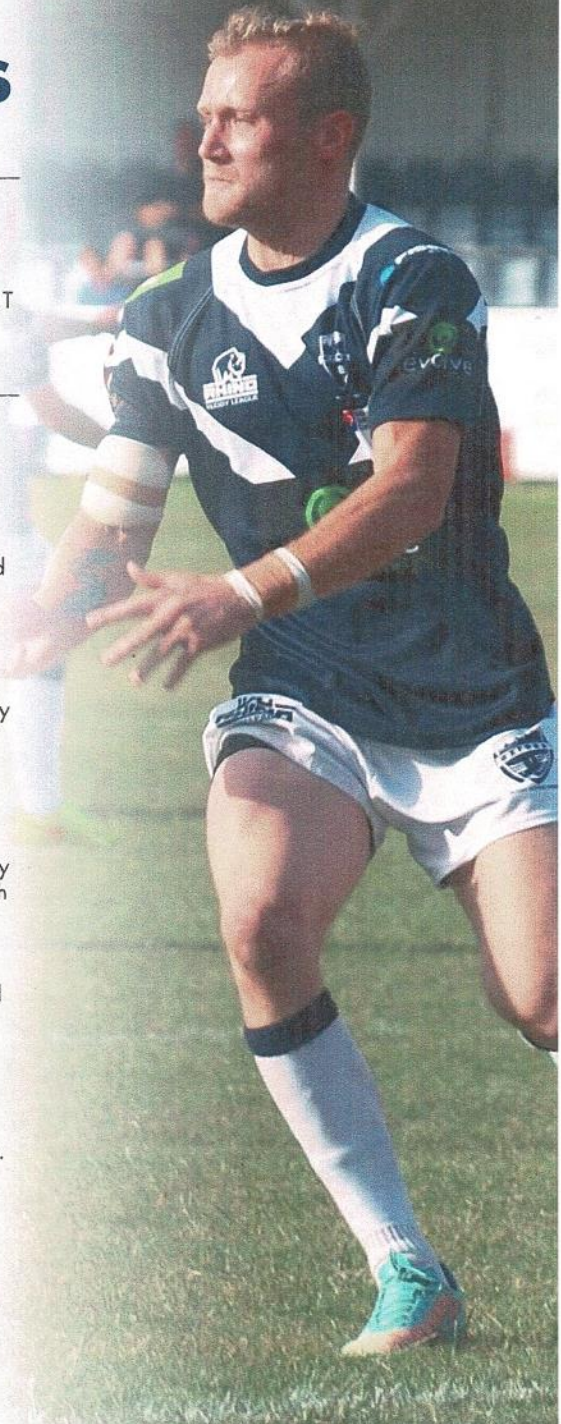

I'd like to thank all the players and their families

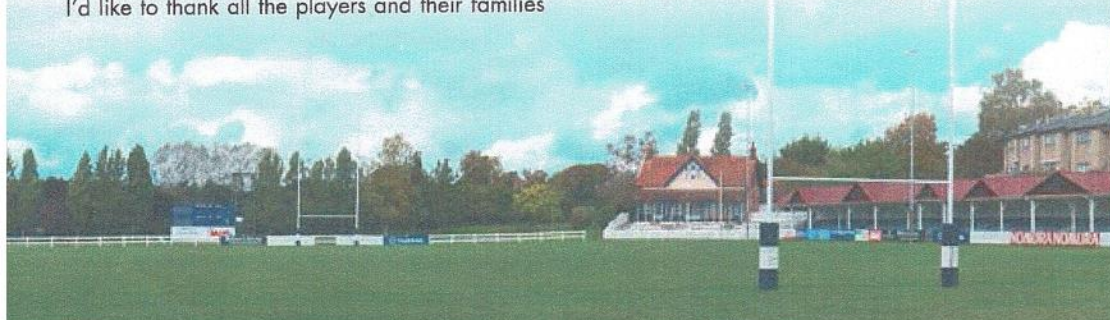
for their commitment and support to the Blues. It has been great to see players' parents, wives and girlfriends getting behind the team.

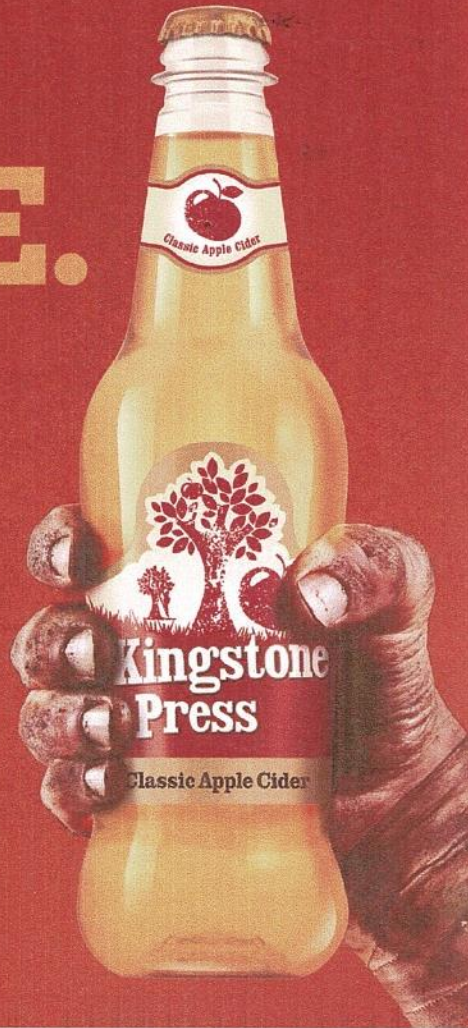
