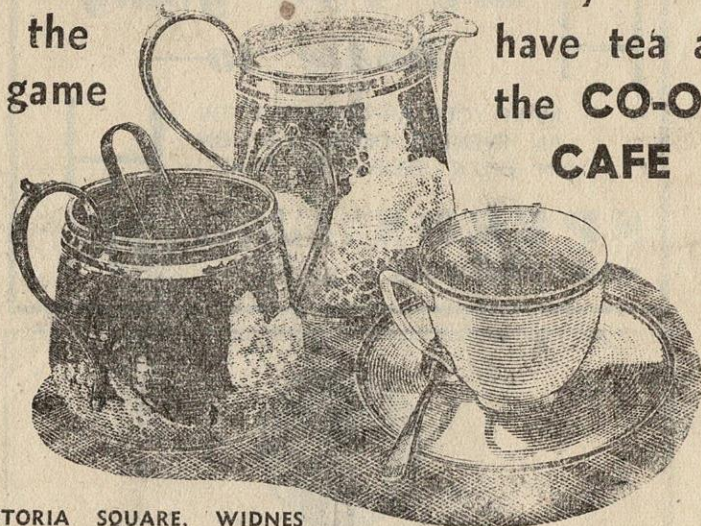

## Notes

### Last Saturday's Victory

### DO YOU KNOW?

1. That trainers must not enter the field of play until requested to do so by the referee? When play is stopped because of injury, referees shall ensure that trainers move injured players to touch-line with the minimum of delay.
2. When a player is dismissed by a referee because of the intervention of a touch-judge, the latter must always submit a report to the League Secretary, and also send a copy to the player's club.
3. A player may return to the field of play when permitted to do so by a touch-judge, but such permission can only be granted when play is stopped.
4. The recognised interval for Northern League matches is five minutes. Clubs wishing to extend this period should first seek permission from the Management Committee in order that referees may be informed.
5. Referee must report fully on any delays in kick-off times.
