NEW BOARD

Since the publication of the last Hornets' match programme an extraordinary meeting of shareholders on March 18th appointed a new board of directors, the board now comprising: Councillor J. Lindley (Chairman), and Messrs. G. Halligan, C. Crossley, R. Seeley, L. Greenwood, R. H. Lord and J. J. Fov.

FINANCES

Otherwise the Watersheddings' thirteen is the best that can be fielded. and the Hornets will have their work cut out to administer a set-back to their opponents' first-four aspirations.

WIGAN NEXT

On Saturday the Hornets have another attractive home fixture. Wigan visit the

Athletic Grounds, where there should be the best "gate" of the season. Then on Good Friday, Leigh, who are also aiming to finish in one of the top four places, pay their visit to Rochdale.

THE WIDNES MATCH

The Hornets threw away a fine opportunity of scoring their first away win of the season at Naughton Park last Saturday. Five minutes before halftime they were leading by ten points to five and Widnes had been reduced to eleven men due to injuries to Naughton and Shaw. But Widnes brought out typical fighting spirit, plus better method, and in the end were worthy winners by 23 points to 13.

"A" TEAM'S SUCCESSES

By far the brightest spot at the Athletic Grounds at the moment is the form of the "A" team who have won four of their last five engagements, their only defeat being at Watersheddings. A win was secured at St. Helens, and defeats have been inflicted at the Athletic Grounds on Leigh "A," Oldham "A" and Widnes "A."
