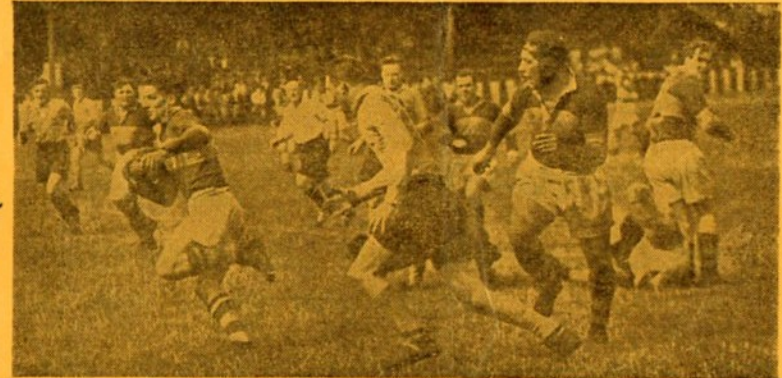

## PROGRAMME NOTES — SATURDAY, 23rd MARCH, 1957

Our splendid win against Hunslet a fortnight ago was somewhat nullified by an indifferent display given by our team at Mount Pleasant last Saturday. For some unaccountable reason we saw very little of the ball from the scrum, otherwise there would have been a different result.

Our young scrum-half, Brian Harrison, gave the impression that with a little more experience and a little less haste in placing the ball in the scrum, he will make a first class player. The opening he made for Willie Rushton to score his try was sufficient proof of a football brain and we were well satisfied with his debut.

Congratulations to George Langfield who has already scored 99 goals and 9 tries (225 points) and beaten the Club record of 224 points scored by Johnny Wilson two seasons ago.

### To-day's Visitors:

To-day we welcome Oldham to the Barley Mow. Earlier this season they had hopes of pulling off that rarest of Rugby League performances—the winning of all Four Cups. They were holding the Lancashire Cup won by defeating St. Helens in October and were running well in the other competitions, but "there's many a slip" and Oldham made theirs at Leigh in the 2nd Round of the Challenge Cup last month.

Now, they still have a good chance of the Lancashire League and the Northern R.L. Championship and may be depended upon to make every effort to secure two more points to-day. Our lads may have other ideas however, and we have in fact beaten the Watersheddings men at Bramley in post-war football.

The Oldham F.C. is that comparative rarity in rugby circles—a "member's club", and the feeling of belonging to the club has always fostered the keenest interest in "the Roughyeds" amongst the folk of the Spindletown. The period of the early 1920's was one of the club's greatest eras, and during that time they figured in four successive Challenge Cup Finals, and during that great run between 1924 and 1927 they won the trophy twice, beating Hull Kingston Rovers 16—3 in 1925 and Swinton 26—7 in 1927.

They have always had some fine forwards at Oldham, and stars of their four-finals years included those great foragers Albert Brough, Herman Hilton and Bob Sloman—the latter one of the finest forwards playing in the between-wars period. Amongst top-class Oldham backs of that period were Test Match caps T. E. ("Guardsman") Rees, and that speedy winger Sid Rix, whilst Jackie Oster played out-half in Test football too.

In post-war years our visitors' star performers have included Test players Alan Davies, Terry O'Grady (now with Wigan), Sid Little, and loose-forward Derek Turner. One of their outstanding players, now recently retired from active football, was Bryn Goldswain, a Welsh international who played a big part in the club's rehabilitation after the War. Oldham's complete honours list is:—

**Challenge Cup winners:** 1925. 1927. (four times runners-up).

**Championship winners:** 1910. 1911. (five times runners-up).

**Lancashire Cup:** 6 wins, present holders. **Laucs. League:** 3 wins.
